- the itinerary must include three or more NT Learning Adventures (NTLA) operators.

Terms and conditions

NT Learning Adventures Save and Learn program

Any Australian school group, from outside the Northern Territory (NT), is invited to submit an application for funding to support their NT school tour. The planned excursion simply needs to meet the following requirements:

- minimum of 10 students in the group
- staying at least five nights in the in the NT
- the itinerary must include at least three NT Learning Adventures (NTLA) operators (excluding accommodation and other services). Alternatively, itineraries delivered by an NTLA operator that include extended cultural immersion elements in remote communities may also be eligible (at the discretion of Tourism NT). A list of current NTLA partners can be found at ntlearningadventures.com.

School tours departing from 1 January 2024 that complete their travel by 31 December 2024 are eligible for \$2,000 (GST inclusive) funding, per school group. Schools are eligible to claim up to five rebates per calendar year. Each application must be for school groups undertaking tours on different dates and/or itineraries to be eligible.

APPLICATION

All applications must be received at least four weeks prior to travel. Late applications may not be accepted. The application is to be provided by email to education.tourismnt@nt.gov.au and must include:

- completed and signed 'NTLA Save and Learn program' application form
- a detailed itinerary, highlighting the main activities, day by day

APPROVAL

All successful applications will receive an approval notice via email, a reference number and instructions on how to claim.

PAYMENT

The pre-approved funding is claimed after the group has completed their excursion. The funding is paid directly to the school by sending the final itinerary, evidence of payments made to at least three NTLA operators and an invoice to Tourism NT, as per the instructions provided in the approval email. All invoices must be received by Tourism NT no later than 10 days after the group has returned. Late invoices may not be paid.

The school must notify Tourism NT if the planned excursion is amended or cancelled. Prior to making payment, Tourism NT will seek confirmation that travel was completed as per the itinerary provided during application.

Tourism NT reserves the right to change the terms and conditions or terminate the program as required.
