School groups are invited to submit an application for travel to receive \$3,000 funding support to assist in delivering your NT school excursion.

The planned excursion simply needs to meet the following requirements:

- minimum of 10 students in the group
- staying at least five nights in the Northern Territory
- the itinerary must include three or more NT Learning Adventures (NTLA) operators.

## **Terms and conditions** NT Learning Adventures Save and Learn program

Any Australian school group, from outside the Northern Territory (NT), is invited to submit an application for funding to support their NT school tour. The planned excursion simply needs to meet the following requirements:

- minimum of 10 students in the group
- staying at least five nights in the in the NT
- the itinerary must include at least three NT Learning Adventures (NTLA) operators (excluding accommodation and other services). Alternatively, itineraries delivered by an NTLA operator that include extended cultural immersion elements in remote communities may also be eligible (at the discretion of Tourism NT). A list of current NTLA partners can be found at **ntlearningadventures.com**.

School tours departing from 1 January 2023 that complete their travel by 31 December 2023 are eligible for a \$3,000 (GST inclusive) rebate, per school group.

### APPLICATION

All applications must be received at least four weeks prior to travel. Late applications may not be accepted. The application is to be provided by email to **education.tourismnt@nt.gov.au** and must include:

- completed and signed 'NTLA Save and Learn program' registration form
- a detailed itinerary, highlighting the main activities, day by day
- evidence of a financial commitment (partial or full) made by the school towards the excursion such as deposits paid to agents, payments made to operators or purchased flights. Tourism NT reserves the right to substantiate these claims prior to approval.

### APPROVAL

All successful applications will receive an approval notice via email, a reference number and instructions on how to claim. The school is provided with Tourism NT's logo and is encouraged to include it within the communication activities of the excursion. Tourism NT requests evidence of the logo being used.

### PAYMENT

The pre-approved funding is claimed after the group has completed their excursion. The rebate is paid directly to the school by sending an invoice to Tourism NT, as per the instructions provided in the approval email. All invoices must be received by Tourism NT no later than 10 days after the group has returned. Late invoices may not be paid.

The school must notify Tourism NT if the planned excursion is amended or cancelled. Prior to making payment, Tourism NT will seek confirmation that travel was completed as per the itinerary provided during application.

Tourism NT reserves the right to change the terms and conditions or terminate the program as required.
