

KiwiSaver rises to almost NZD 135 billion

Morningstar's quarterly KiwiSaver Survey is designed to help New Zealand investors assess the past performance and other key characteristics of their KiwiSaver superannuation options. The accompanying tables show KiwiSaver fund returns for the three months and one, three, five, and 10 years to September 30 2025.

Key Takeaways

KiwiSaver has become an adult. This is the first quarter, we have 18 years of performance since the start of the scheme. KiwiSaver assets increased, ending the quarter at close to NZD 135 billion rising almost \$5b this quarter due to a combination of strong market returns across the board, and inflows.

- Average multisector category returns for the September quarter ranged between 2.7 percent for conservative and 7.7 percent for aggressive category.
- Over one, three, five and ten years risk continues to be rewarded with the more growth assets in the category the more it has returned this quarter was no exception



Market Commentary

New Zealand Economic & Market Commentary - Q3 2025

Overview

The September quarter marked a constructive period for diversified investors. Falling inflation pressures and the first rate cuts from major central banks helped stabilise bond yields and lifted global equity sentiment. Domestically, the Reserve Bank of New Zealand began its easing cycle, while the New Zealand dollar traded in a relatively narrow range against the US dollar.

Cash

The Reserve Bank reduced the Official Cash Rate to 3.00% in August, its first cut of the cycle. This move reflected confidence that inflation is trending toward the 1–3% target band. Retail deposit and on-call rates have begun to edge lower, signalling that the peak in cash returns has likely passed. While cash continues to provide liquidity and optionality, its relative attractiveness is diminishing as term yields fall.

New Zealand Bonds

Government bonds delivered positive returns as yields declined across the curve. The RBNZ's softer policy stance, combined with easing global inflation, supported demand for duration. Ten-year yields finished the quarter near 4.2%, down from mid-year highs. With inflation expectations contained and the central bank signalling further measured easing, the domestic bond market remains favourably positioned from a total-return perspective.

New Zealand Equities

The local share market produced modest gains over the quarter. Rate-sensitive and dividend-oriented sectors benefited from the easing interest-rate outlook, though earnings momentum remained patchy. Defensive names held ground, and export-exposed companies gained some relief from a stable currency. Overall, the environment improved compared with the soft first half of the year.

Australian Equities

Australian equities extended their outperformance relative to New Zealand, underpinned by strength in financials, healthcare, and select resources exposures. The Reserve Bank of Australia maintained a steady policy stance, helping sustain investor confidence. For New Zealand investors, unhedged returns were slightly tempered by modest currency movements, but overall results were positive.

International Equities

Global markets advanced as the US Federal Reserve delivered its first rate cut in September, reinforcing a soft-landing narrative. Technology, industrials, and European luxury sectors led performance, while Asia ex-Japan benefited from improving sentiment toward emerging markets. Hedged international portfolios performed strongly, and unhedged exposures offered little additional tailwind given the relatively stable currency environment.

Currency Movements

The New Zealand dollar traded between 0.60 and 0.61 against the US dollar during the quarter, ending only slightly softer. The currency was supported by narrowing interest-rate differentials and resilient export prices but constrained by subdued domestic growth. For investors, foreign-exchange effects were largely neutral during the period.

Summary

The third quarter of 2025 reflected a shift in tone—from tightening to easing—as inflation moderated globally. Falling bond yields boosted fixed-income performance, and equity markets responded positively to the more accommodative policy backdrop. Within a diversified portfolio, global and Australian equities led returns, New Zealand bonds delivered solid gains, and cash performance moderated as interest rates declined.



Fund Manager Results

Most Multi-Sector KiwiSaver funds produced positive returns over the June quarter. As for default funds all funds made it to around 5% there or abouts - We have our first \$1 billion default fund, and more on the way.

ASB had a strong quarter with three of its funds in the top of its category and the other two multi-asset funds in the top five performers. Other than ASB, no provider consistently has funds at the top of the category, although a couple of Kernel's low cost multi asset funds had some strong showings.

It is most appropriate to evaluate performance of a KiwiSaver scheme by studying its long-term returns. Over 10 years, the aggressive category average has given investors an annualized return of 10.0%, followed by growth (8.3%), balanced (6.8%), moderate (4.1%), and conservative (3.4%).

The Originals

If we look back very long term, to the start of KiwiSaver just shy of 50 funds that we know about started with KiwiSaver on 01/10/2007 in multi asset class categories and still exist today. In between we have had notable events which shook markets and included the GFC, and COVID to name but a few. While the participation throughout the whole time at category level is small in numbers, you can see below generally, like other periods we look at, risk has been rewarded once again.

Market Share

KiwiSaver assets on the Morningstar database rose strongly during the June quarter to 135 billion. ANZ leads the market share with almost NZD 23 billion. ASB is in second position, with a market share of 14.9%. Then goes Fisher. Milford and Westpac round out the big five. The five largest KiwiSaver providers account for approximately 66% of assets in our database, or around 88 billion dollars under management. We estimate that KiwiSaver providers will charge more than \$1.1b from KiwiSaver members in the next 12 months to manage their KiwiSaver funds, at an average fee of around 0.82 of a cent per dollar invested.

About This Survey

This survey groups KiwiSaver options according to their mix of income and growth assets, or "asset allocation." This is one of the most important decisions to make when saving for retirement. The term "income assets" refers to cash and fixed interest securities that generally produce stable and reliable returns but offer little opportunity for long-term capital growth. Returns from "growth assets" such as property and shares can be volatile—as recent market conditions have demonstrated—but over time have shown greater capacity for increasing in value. The mixture of income and growth assets is the major determinant of potential return and volatility.

Investors may notice differences between the returns published in this survey and those they see elsewhere. There are several possible reasons for this. First, the returns published here are after fees but before tax. Second, we take the associated tax credit into consideration when calculating and publishing these returns, while some fund managers base their published performance figures on month-end unit prices only.
