The current BSA locations are Boston, Coral Gables, New York City and Washington D.C. A BSA Coordinator assists all our foreign students. Group programs are not offered at all locations. Please note that Total Immersion® and Private programs can be taken at any of our Berlitz Centers in the U.S.

Program description

There are five course offerings, priced per person, and do not include Homestay. All BSA programs include a welcome packet, tuition, registration fee and only materials for one level. A level assessment is given upon student's arrival at the language center and may be subject to change within first week. Students on an **F-1** Visa must attend 18 hours of instruction per week.

The following Private programs are offered at all Berlitz-US language centers and include a customized curriculum for level 1-10. Customized programs focus on student's individual goals. With each new level attained, students must purchase additional materials at the language center. Lessons are 45 minutes each and include a five minute break.

Less than 7 days or no show - NO REFUND. If I must cancel my program and/ or Homestay accommodations, I will send the BSA department, via email or fax, a notice of cancellation.

Important information

Please keep in mind that homestay may not be suitable for everyone.

- All host families are approximately 40 to 60 minutes from the Language Center.
- · Note that prices differ for New York City for outside and inside city limits.

Airport Transportation is only available for students requesting Host Family Accommodation.

- An additional charge may be incurred on arrivals between 12:00 AM and 6:00 AM.
 Please note: you should arrive at the host family no earlier than 7 AM and no later than 10 PM.
- You must notify us 24 hours in advance or full one way transportation will be charged.
- If your flight is delayed there will be on extra charge of \$50.
- If your flight is canceled, it is the responsibility of the student to contact the BSA Department and inform of any changes. The full service fee may be charged if no call or e-mail is received in a timely manner.
- If you do not locate your driver and you do not call the transportation company at the 800 toll-free number listed on the course confirmation, a full service fee will be charged.

How to enroll for a BSA language program

- · Send your completed application form with signatures
- Pay the BSA 15% deposit (tuition only) plus the \$100 non-refundable registration fee
- If requesting an I-20, you must provide proof of sufficient funds to meet your living and tuition expenses, as well as living expenses of family members traveling with you on student-dependent (F-2) Visas. Submit your financial documentation in English. Any one of the following is acceptable:
 - A current personal bank statement or an original letter from your bank
 - A letter/affidavit of support from your parents or other source of support stating
 that they will be responsible for your expenses during your stay at Berlitz, and a
 bank statement verifying their financial ability to meet your expenses
 - · A letter guaranteeing financial support from your employer
 - An original scholarship letter from your government or other organization
- · Copy of your passport picture page (when requesting an I-20)

Acceptance

Once BSA has received your completed & signed application, documents and deposit, it will take approximately 3 to 4 business days to process your enrollment. You will receive via e-mail an Acceptance Letter, Course Confirmation and Homestay, and airport pick-up information, if applicable. If requesting Form I-20, it will be mailed via Express Courier. The fee for the International express courier service is \$75 and for domestic it is \$35.

Arrival into the U.S.

When traveling be sure to carry your Course Confirmation Acceptance Letter, Form I-20 (if applicable), Homestay & airport pick-up confirmation.

On your first day

Berlitz suggests that ALL students arrive 30-minutes before the start of class on the first day of class. All students will be evaluated for level placement.

Please bring your passport, your original I-20 Form, your stamped I-94 Form (arrival/departure record filled out on your flight to the U.S.), funds to pay all remaining program fees at Berlitz, signed health waiver on page 4, and proof of medical insurance (if not purchased through Berlitz).



General information (regarding F-1 students)

Attendance

In order to get the maximum benefit from the program students should attend all classes. Students on a F-1 Student Visa MUST attend classes a minimum of 18 hours per week and maintain an 80% cumulative attendance record.

Students must complete a Multi-Purpose Request Form for the following:

- A break in study (vacation)—students can only receive a break in study after completing 26 weeks of study
- · Transferring to another school
- · Extending your BSA Program

Students on an F-1 Visa must notify the center and inform the BSA Coordinator if you can not attend class. Students who have 3 consecutive absences must provide a doctor's note explaining the absence. NOTE: Students maximum total length of language training cannot exceed 36 months at Berlitz.

Students are responsible for maintaining proper status of their F-1 Student Visa.

Registration & payment fees

All payments must be in U.S. Dollars – payments can be made via Wire Transfer (fee of \$35), or by any major credit card. If paying by credit card please complete the Credit Card Payment Authorization section on page 4. If paying via wire transfer please remit the full-payment to:

How to obtain a Student Visa

According to U.S. immigration laws, you must enter the United States on a non-immigrant, student (F-1) visa if you wish to study more than 18 hours per week. Berlitz Study Abroad Centers are authorized, under federal law to enroll non-immigrant alien students. To obtain an F-1 student visa and make an appointment at U.S. Embassy for a personal interview, you will need to pay a SEVIS Fee (NOT a Berlitz Fee) at www.FMJfee. com. You must print the receipt and present if to the U.S. Embassy or U.S. Consulate along with certain documents to demonstrate your intent to study in the United States and, after completion of your studies, return to your home country. The documents you need: Form I-20 obtained from Berlitz; proof of financial certification; a valid passport; and evidence of ties to your country. We recommend that you make an appointment for your interview at least 60-120 days before the date you intend to begin your studies. You can find more information on how to apply for a student visa, including the required visa application, on the U.S. Embassy and U.S. consulate website. A listing may be found at http://usembassy.state.gov/.

Refund and cancellation policy

- If you cancel your program or your VISA is denied, you will receive a full refund of
 tuition and fees (including any fees paid for health insurance.) The \$100 registration
 fee, host family accommodation fees, and all courier fees are non-refundable. If
 Berlitz terminates your enrollment prior to the start of your program, however, you
 will receive a full refund of tuition and fees including the registration fee.
- If you cancel or Berlitz terminates your enrollment after classes have begun in a Total Immersion® or Private program, you will be refunded for all lessons not taken; however, the \$100 registration fee, host family accommodation fees, and all courier fees are non-refundable.
- If you cancel or Berlitz terminates your enrollment after classes have begun in a
 Combination or Small Group program, you will be refunded for the weeks not taken;
 however, the \$100 registration fee, host family accommodation fees, and all courier
 fees are non-refundable. If your enrollment is cancelled or terminated, Berlitz will, as
 required by federal law, notify U.S. Immigration and Customs Inforcement (ICE) that
 you are no longer pursuing a full course of study and, therefore, are in violation of your
 F-1 (student) visa status.
- If Berlitz does not accept your application, Berlitz will refund you the application fee, as well as any tuition collected.
- Refunds will be made within 30 calendar days of your cancellation or withdrawal from the program. Refunds will be processed in the same method which payment was received.
- Homestay cancellation fees more than 30 days before homestay arrival only the homestay booking fee of \$80 is non-refundable. 30 to 15 days before Homestay arrival – 50% refund of Homestay cost. 14 to 7 days before Homestay arrival – 25% refund of Homestay cost. Less than 7 days or no show – NO REFUND.
