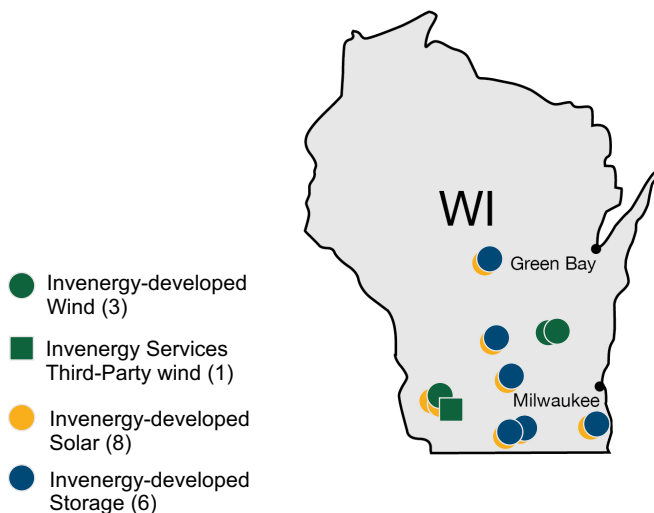


Wisconsin localities benefit directly from hosting utility scale wind and solar. The utility aid shared revenue program distributed over \$76 million to local governments in 2021.
