More than **\$20.8 million** invested annually in local taxes, land costs and lease payments, and project-generated wages and benefits



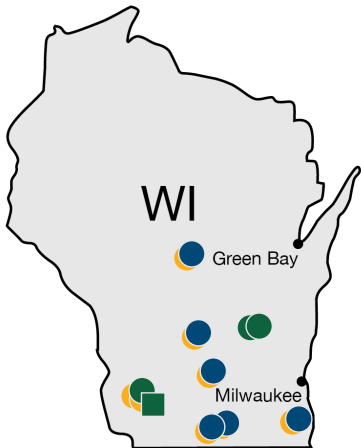
