Invenergy has completed development on 5 sustainable energy projects in Ohio and is pursuing additional opportunities in the state.

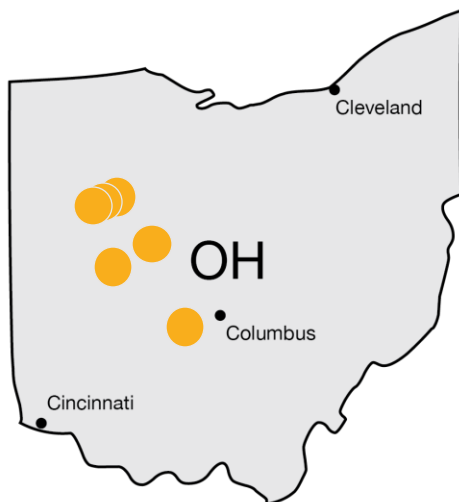
