Invenergy has completed development on 18 energy projects in Iowa and is pursuing additional opportunities in the state.

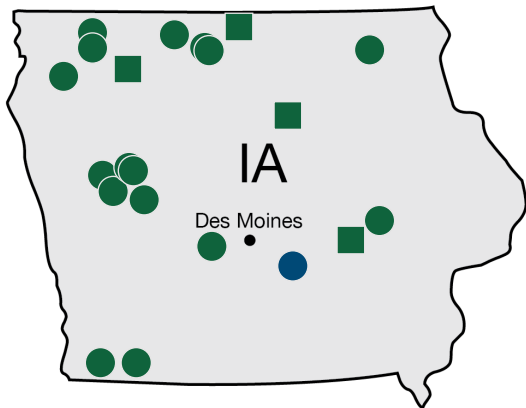


Did You Know:
