Invenergy has completed development on **5 sustainable energy projects in Oklahoma** and is pursuing additional opportunities in the state.

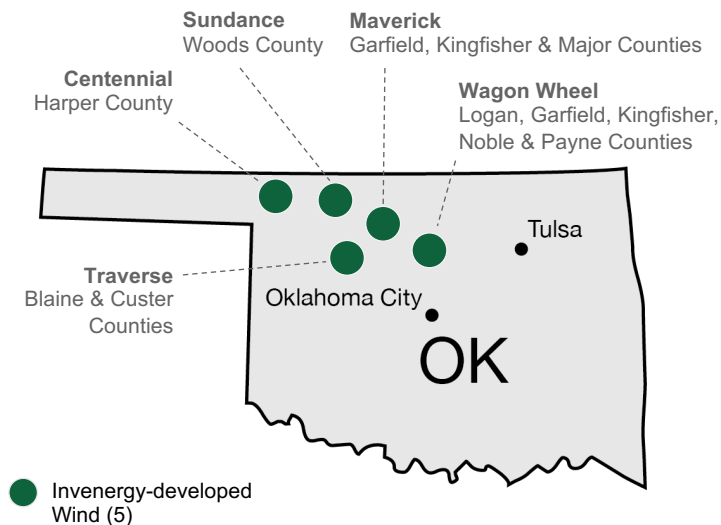
