Invenergy has completed development on **7 sustainable energy projects in New York** and is pursuing additional opportunities in the state.



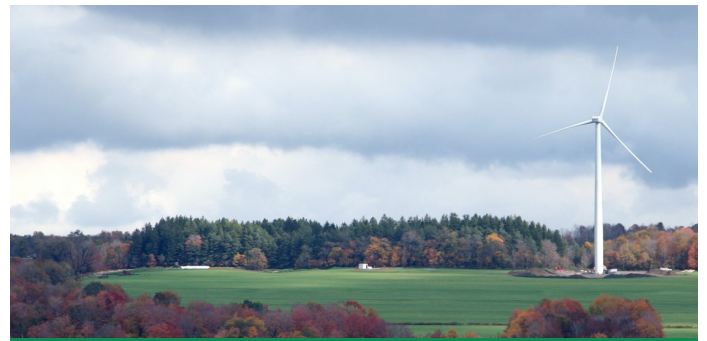
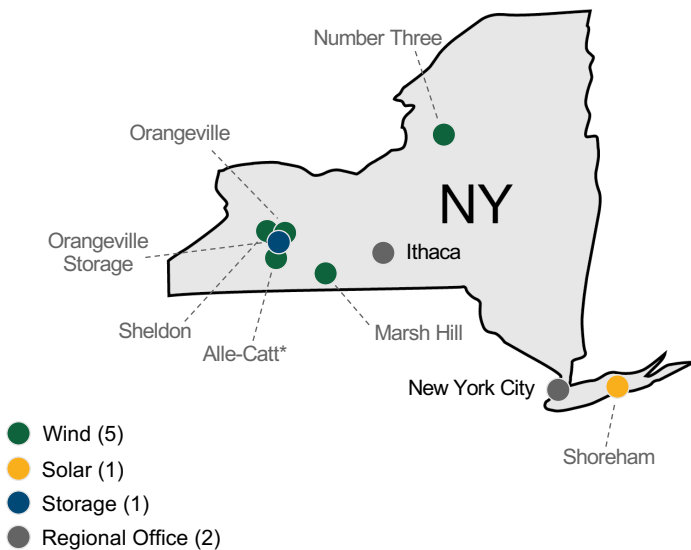

## State Highlights
