- Additional levels will be added as needed.

- **\$300 buy-in (\$240 prize pool + \$60 administrative fee).** Players start with **20,000 tournament chips.**
- Administrative fee includes any and all staffing / dealer fees, and rake.
- Registration will remain open until the start of level 10, eliminated players may re-enter until this time. All original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter. Players may forfeit or surrender their chips to re-enter.
- A player who has not taken a hand by the start of the third level may be considered a “no show” and have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- This tournament is scheduled as one-day tournament*. The Tournament Director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.
- There will be a 15-minute break approximately every 90 minutes of play and a 60-minute dinner break after 6 hours of play.
- “Seniors” tournaments are open to all players 50 years of age or older.
