Players will start with **30,000 in tournament chips**.

Registration will remain open until the start of level 10, eliminated players may re-enter until this time at registration. All original fees apply.

Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter.

Players may forfeit or surrender their chips to re-enter. All original fees apply.

Players may choose to start on and/or re-enter any flight.

A player who has not taken a hand by the start of the third level may be considered a "no show" and have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.

This tournament is scheduled as two-day tournament.

The Tournament Director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.

There will be a 15-minute break approximately every 2 hours of play. There will be a 60-minute dinner break after 6 hours of play.

Day 1 will play until the completion of level 18 OR approximately 5% of the entrants, or 9 players unless otherwise announced by the tournament staff.

Day 2, all Flights will merge at 1:00 PM Sunday.
