Helping you transition from rehabilitation back to the community

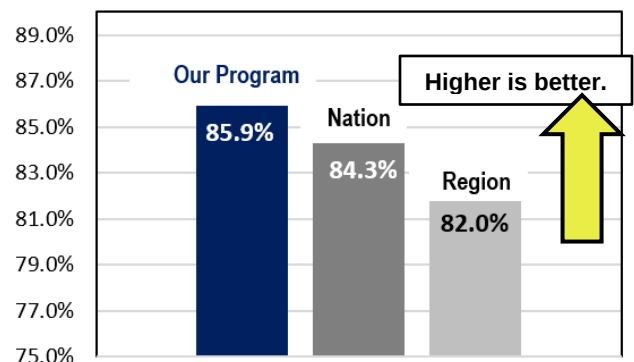
Our goal is to help each patient to recover as much of their independence as possible in the shortest amount of time (length of stay) to be able to get back home.

85.9% of our patients discharged to the community.

- 37% went home with home health services.
- 48% home without home health services.
- 8% needed inpatient subacute rehabilitation

The 2024 average length of stay for all patients who receive rehabilitation on our unit was 12.7 days.

Recovering independence through mobility

Mobility and independence start with having enough strength to get in and out of bed, stand up and transfer from surface to surface, and move around through use of a wheelchair or by walking. We ensure our patients are prepared for discharge, so they experience improvement well beyond their discharge from our program.

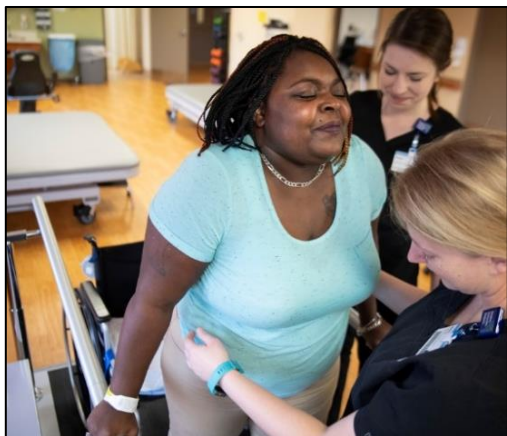
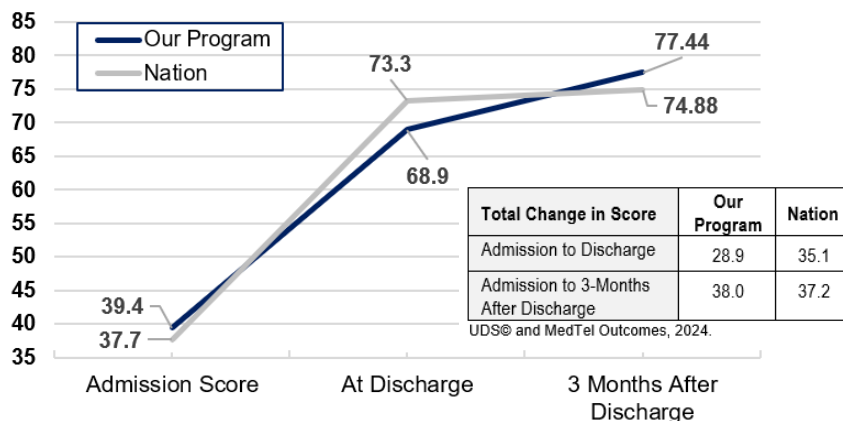

Caring for your medical and rehabilitation needs in one place

Our rehab unit is located within Blodgett Hospital, which offers added benefits to our patients including:

Our experienced medical team has access to specialists to manage your complex medical needs, reducing the need to return to the hospital.

Quick access to imaging and lab testing at Blodgett Hospital.

A single electronic medical record allowing your care team timely access to medical test results.

Our 24/7 rehab doctors (physiatrists) work closely with rehab nurses, therapists, and other doctors to provide exceptional medical rehabilitation. In 2024, 9.1% of our patients had a medical complication that required them to return to the hospital during their rehab stay, which is similar to regional average (8.6%).
