Geriatric Programs offered by Corewell Health in West Michigan:

- **Home Based Primary Care:** A team-based, in-home primary care program which provides physician/advanced practice professionals, RN care managers, social workers, and medical assistants to 830 frail, elderly patients in a 10-county area in West Michigan. This value-based model of care is funded via Corewell Health's insurance plan, Priority Health.
- **Bridging Older Adult Care Program (Back Up):** A value-based and team-based care model that bridges the gap between hospital and home, providing extensive in-home medical management with the goal of medical stabilization and prevention of re-hospitalization.
- **Long Term Care Facilities:** 4 physicians and 14 APPs provide primary care and medical directorship to 5 Corewell Health in West Michigan skilled nursing facilities and 2 local continuing care communities, as well as medical care to 11 area Assisted Living Facilities.
- **Geriatric Ambulatory Care:** A clinical model allows patients living in the community access to ambulatory primary care and consultation that specializes in the needs of patients who are frail and elderly.
- **Geriatric Inpatient Consult Service:** Provides consultation on the specific needs of older inpatients (currently trauma patients and expanding to orthopedic trauma), ensuring that the patient and family's goals of care are identified and honored as well as facilitating appropriate medication management and discharge planning.
- **PACE (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly):** Our team partners with and provides medical direction, clinical, and leadership support for local area PACE programs.

New Digs Coming for the Fuller Street RNC Family

Spectrum Health's Rehab and Nursing Center Breaks Ground on New Campus in Grand Rapids

BHSH Spectrum Health West Michigan has started construction on a new rehabilitation and nursing center to replace the current continuing care facility located at 750 Fuller Street.

The new skilled rehab and nursing facility will be located at 1226 Cedar Street NE in Grand Rapids. It will accommodate 120 long-term residents in a mix of semi-private and private rooms. An additional five beds will be dedicated to acute hospice care.

The facility will also include an on-site dialysis center and therapeutic programs such as art therapy.

The 94,000+ square foot facility includes spaces constructed to feel like home—all living space will be on one level, with easy access to the outdoors, including several courtyards. Residents will be attended by a care team around the clock, to provide services, care and companionship that enhances quality of life and comfort for end of life.

The new facility was designed by the architecture and engineering firm Progressive AE and will be constructed by The Christman Company. It is also made possible by a special land use permit by the Grand Rapids Planning Commission and the generous support of the Kent Community Health Foundation.

The facility is scheduled to open in the spring of 2024.



The new 94,000-square-foot rehab and nursing facility will accommodate 120 residents in mix of semi-private and private rooms, with on-site dialysis center and acute hospice care.
