



Child and Family Life

The program encompasses Blue Glass TV, Music Therapy and the Hospital School Program, consisting of 40 certified professionals. Gifts help supplement endowments and contributions to sustain the program.



Family Life Facility K-9

In 2024, we welcomed Indi, our first HDVCH therapy dog, and her handler, Spencer. Indi reduces anxiety in sedation areas and provides comfort throughout the hospital. Gifts help support Indi's ongoing nutrition and veterinary expenses.



Nutrition Support for Nursing Mothers

These funds provide a meal tray for any nursing mother with a child in the NICU. This nutrition supports recovery and healing for both mother and child, which is critical for premature or compromised newborns.



Surgical Spine Navigation

A 7D surgical spine navigation system helps in reducing radiation exposure and improving patient safety in pediatric spine deformity surgery. This technology enhances screw placement accuracy and allows safer fixation during correction.
