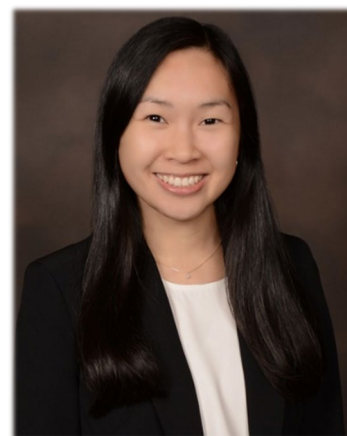
Selena Beck, PharmD (PGY2 Ambulatory Care)
