Future opportunities at our Ampol Kurnell site



We recently advised in our Kurnell Community Update, August 2023, that as part of Ampol's Future Energy and Decarbonisation strategies, we are exploring how we can better support our customers, employees, and the communities in which we operate through playing a leading role in Australia's energy transition. This includes looking at how we can better utilise our land and assets across Australia, including our site at Kurnell.

Following the refinery closure and the demolition of redundant assets, remediation of vacant land within the Kurnell site has been undertaken. A strategic review is being carried out to look at what opportunities exist for this area of land. The review is in the early investigation stage and may include locating new energy solutions on the site such as a grid scale battery which aligns with our Future Energy and Decarbonisation strategies.

Should the project progress, it will follow the NSW State Significant Development pathway which includes multiple stages of consultation and an opportunity to make a formal submission to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment.
