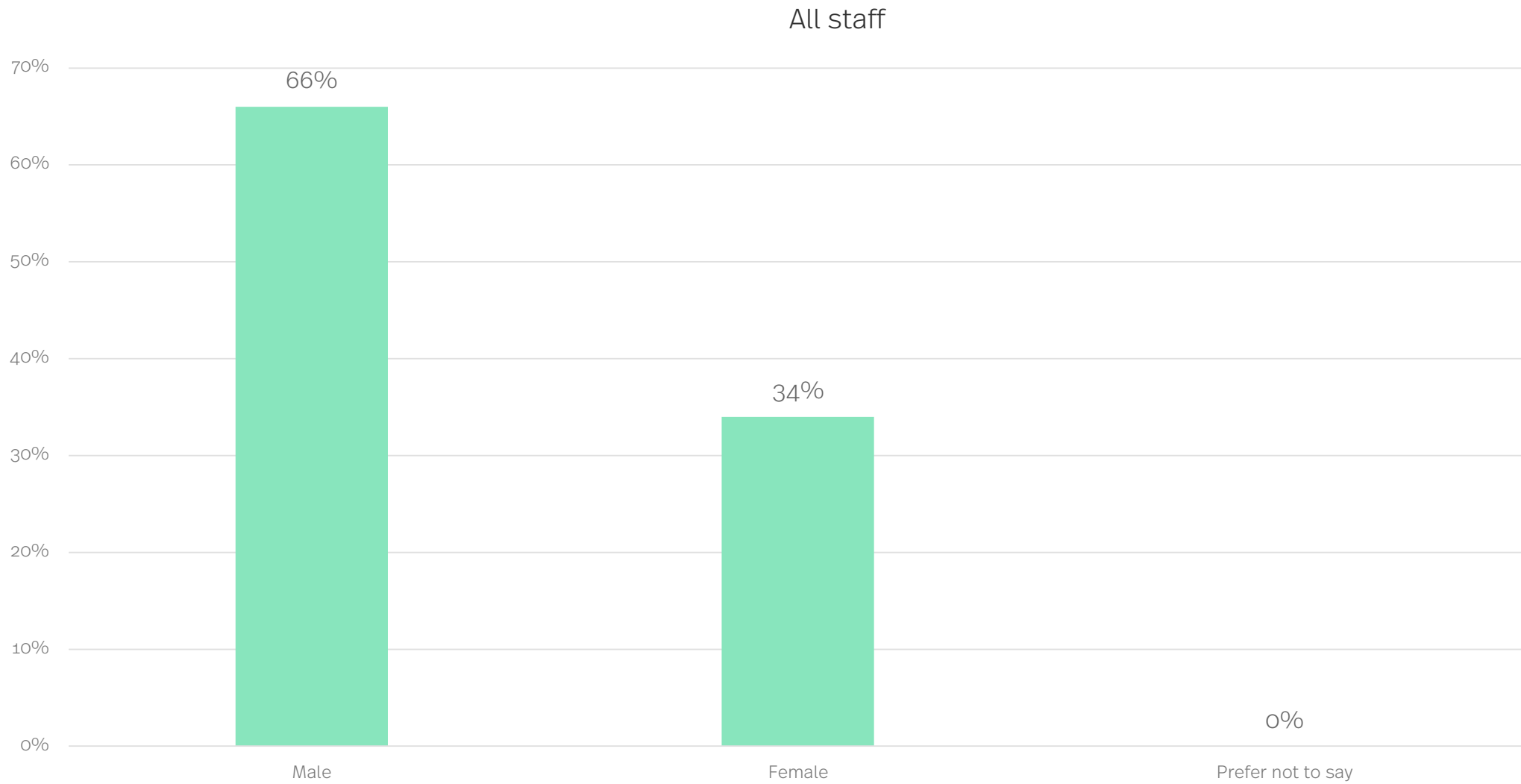

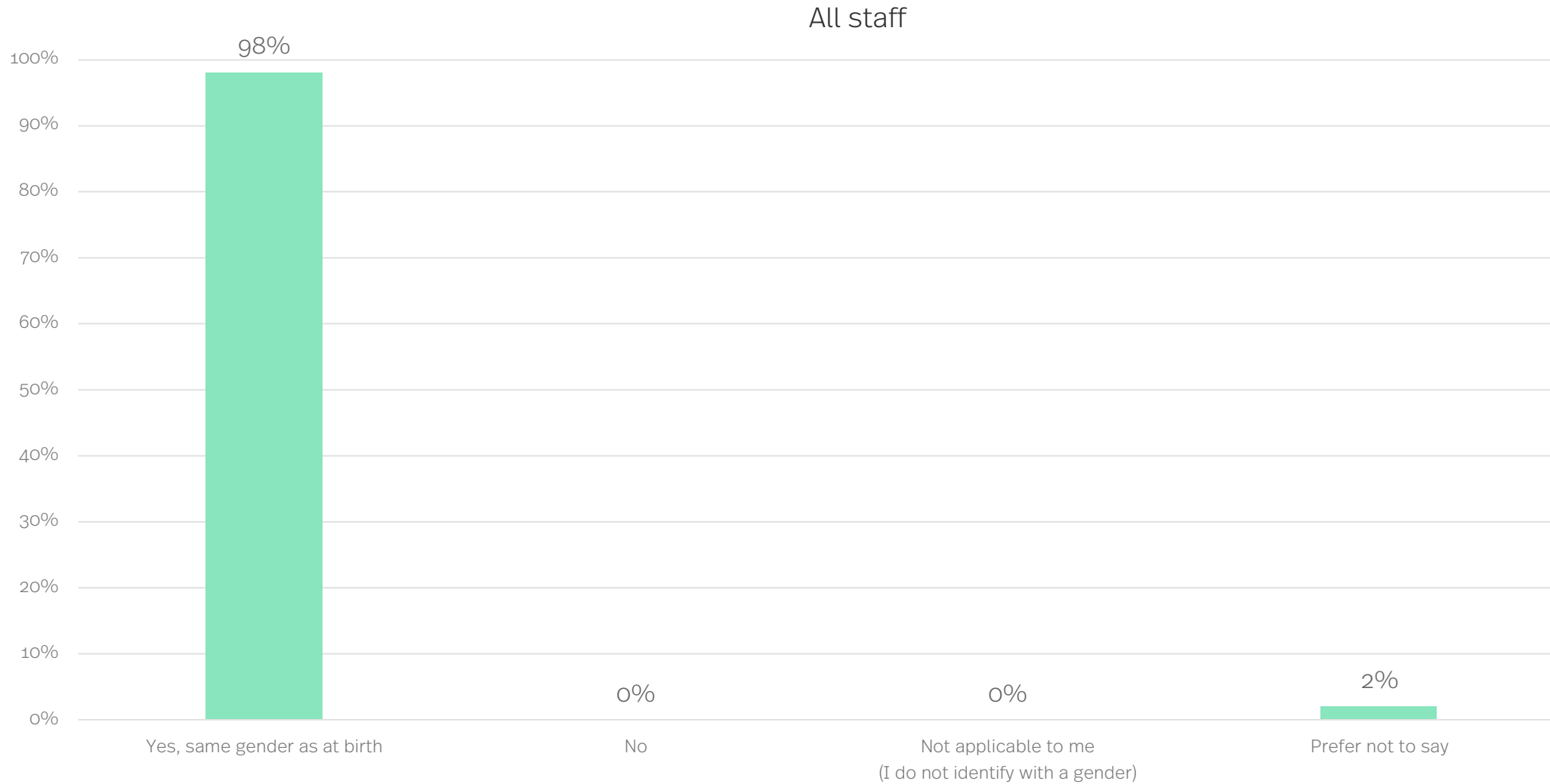
Data reported represents those who completed the 2026 Ireland Diversity Audit
The completion rate in Ireland for 2026 is 73%.



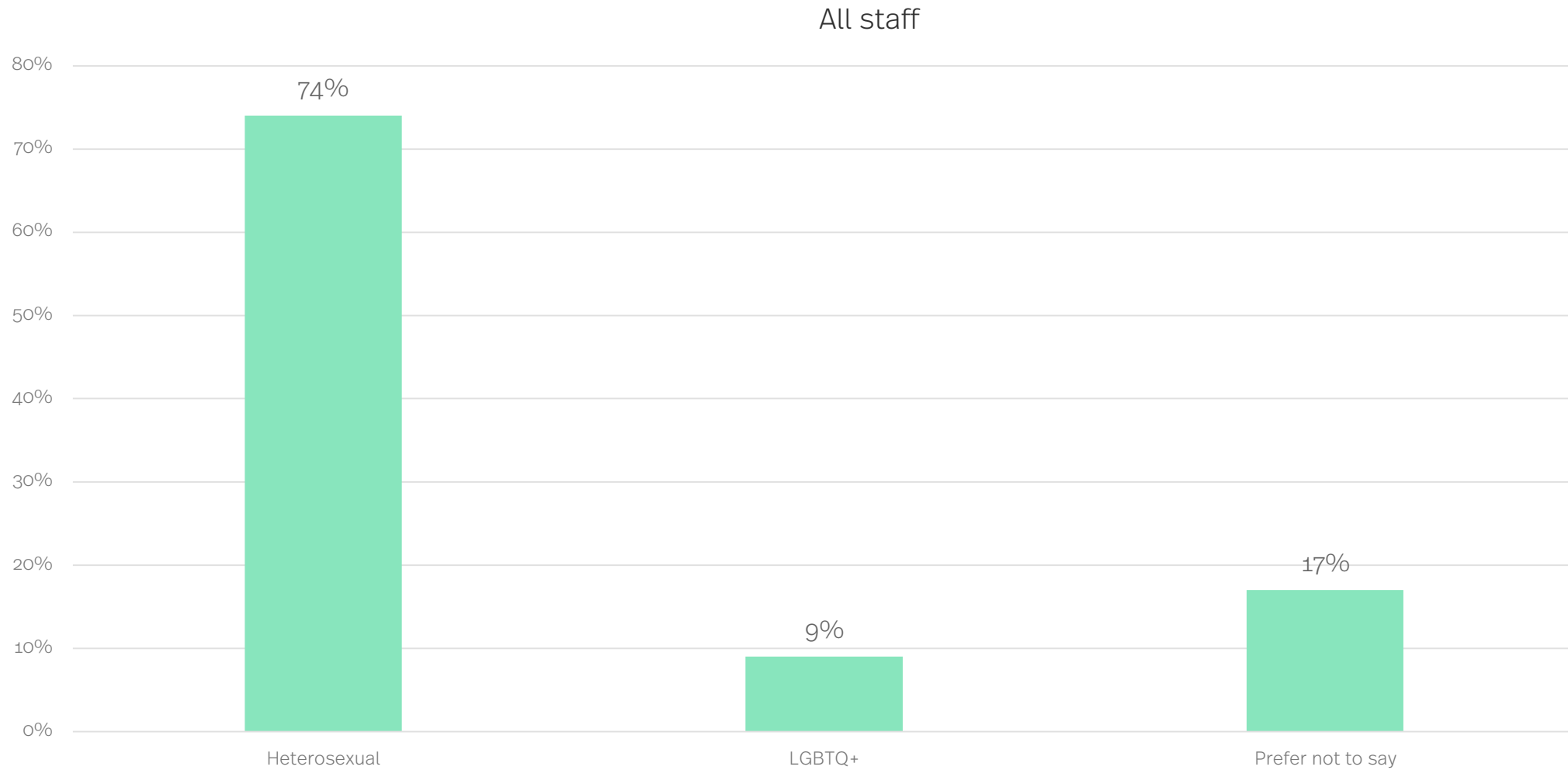
Gender



Is the gender you identify with (if any) the same as your sex at birth?

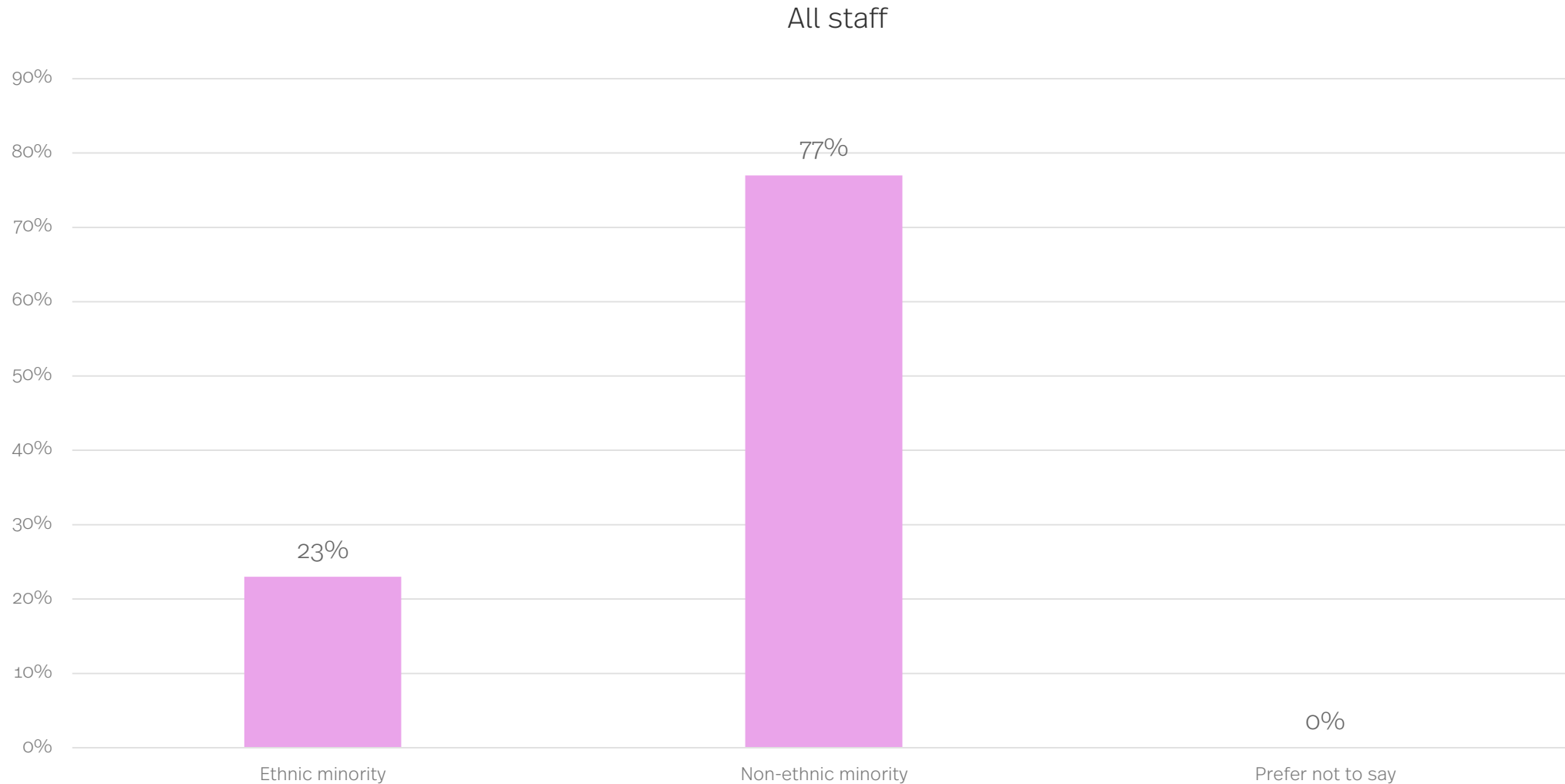


Sexual orientation

Ethnic diversity

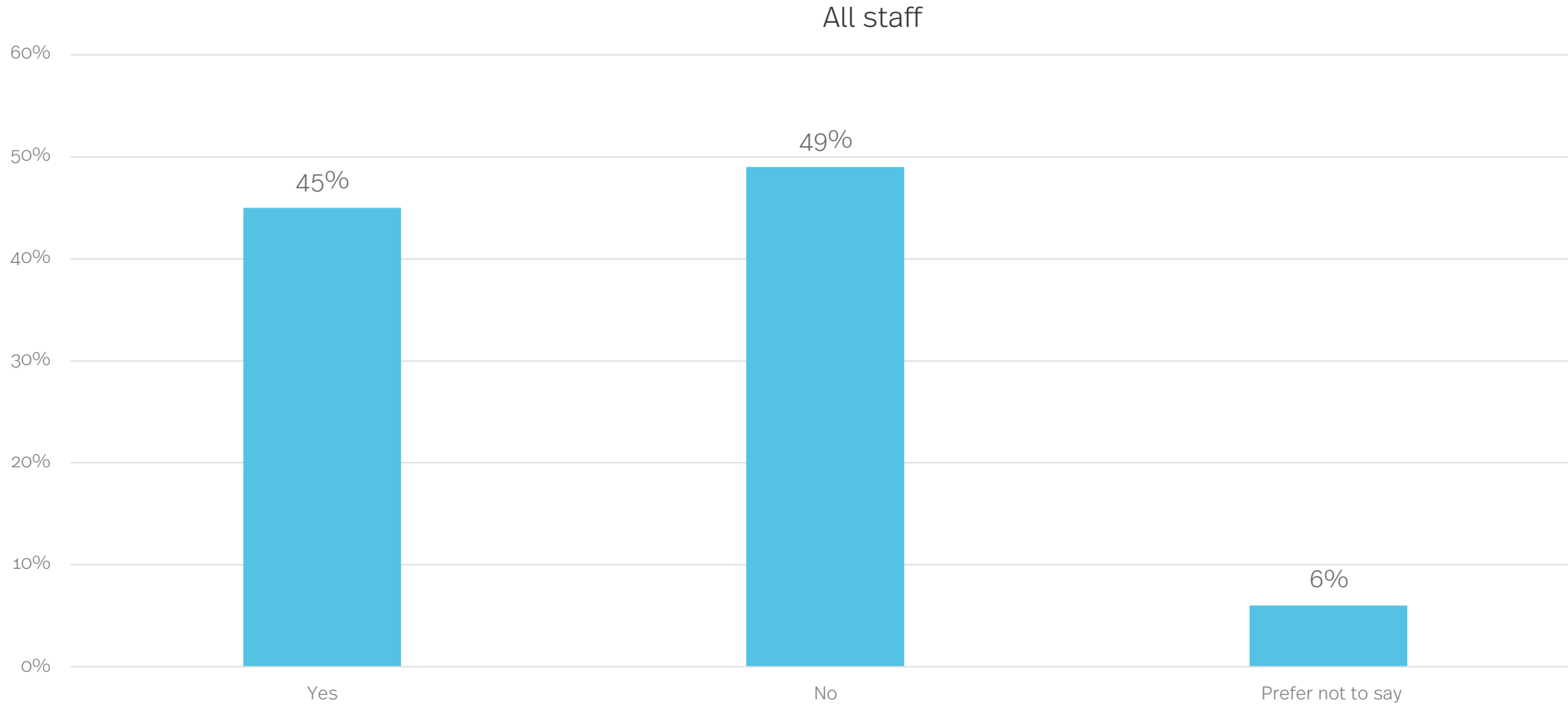

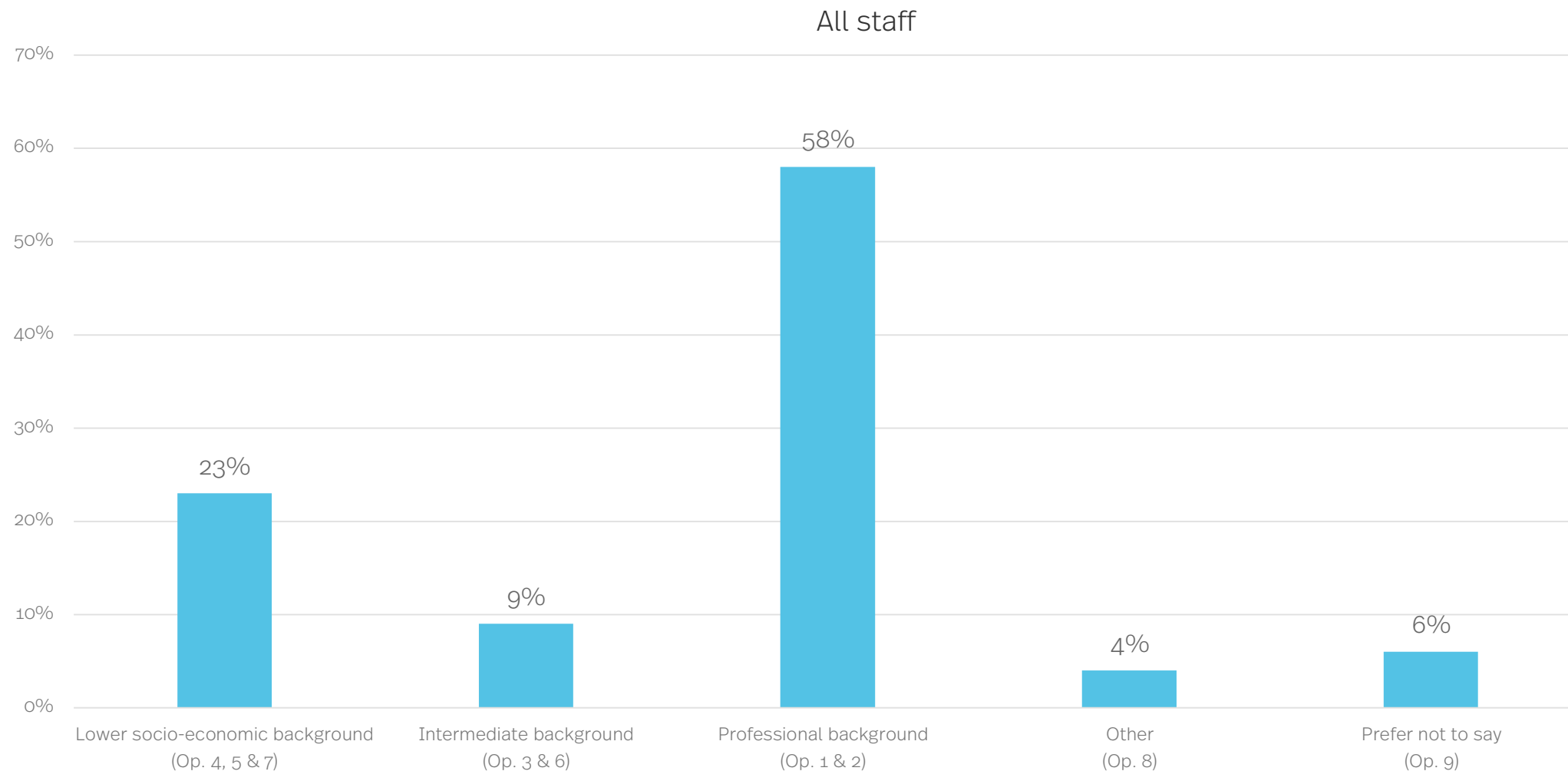
Did either of your parents attend university (or equivalent) and gain a degree (eg BA/BSc or equivalent) by the time you were 18?

What was the occupation of your main household earner when you were about 14?

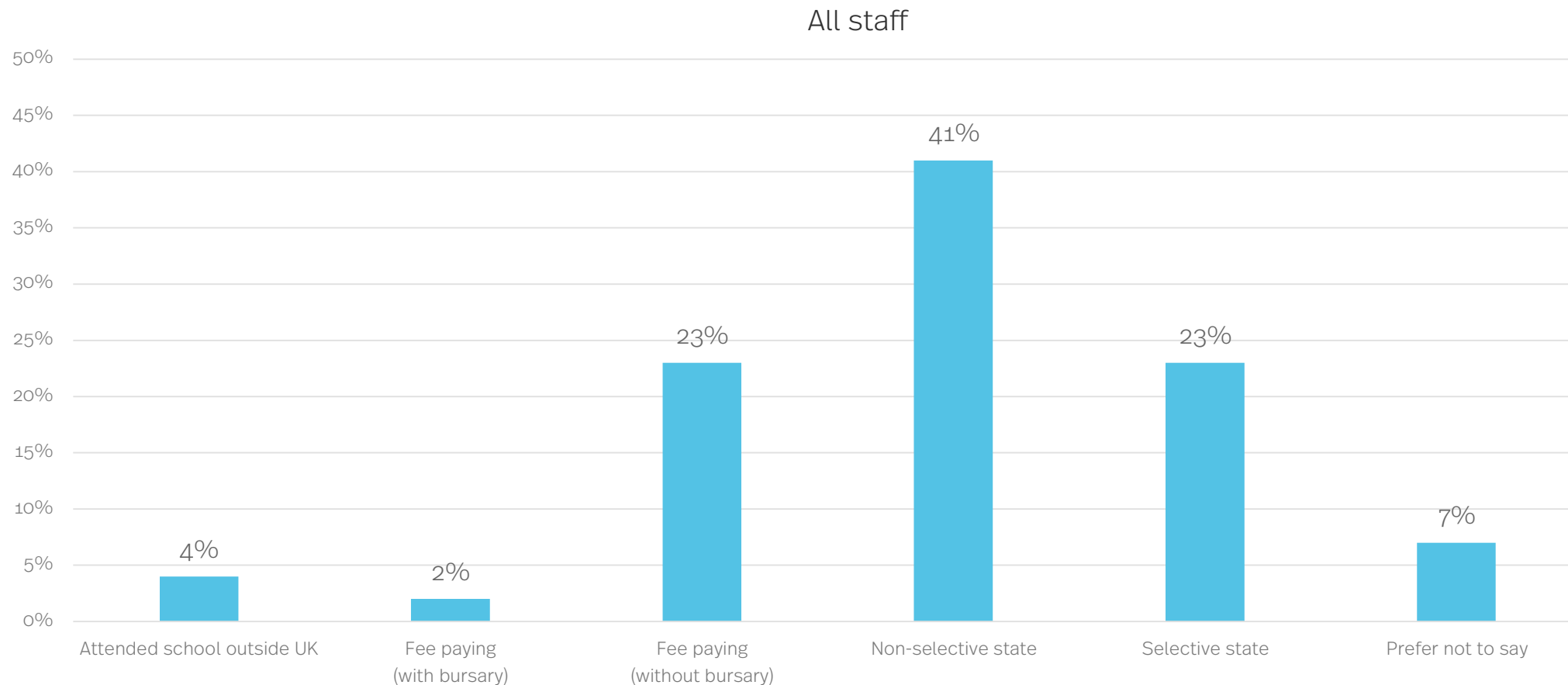

Which type of school did you attend for the most time between ages of 11-16 ?

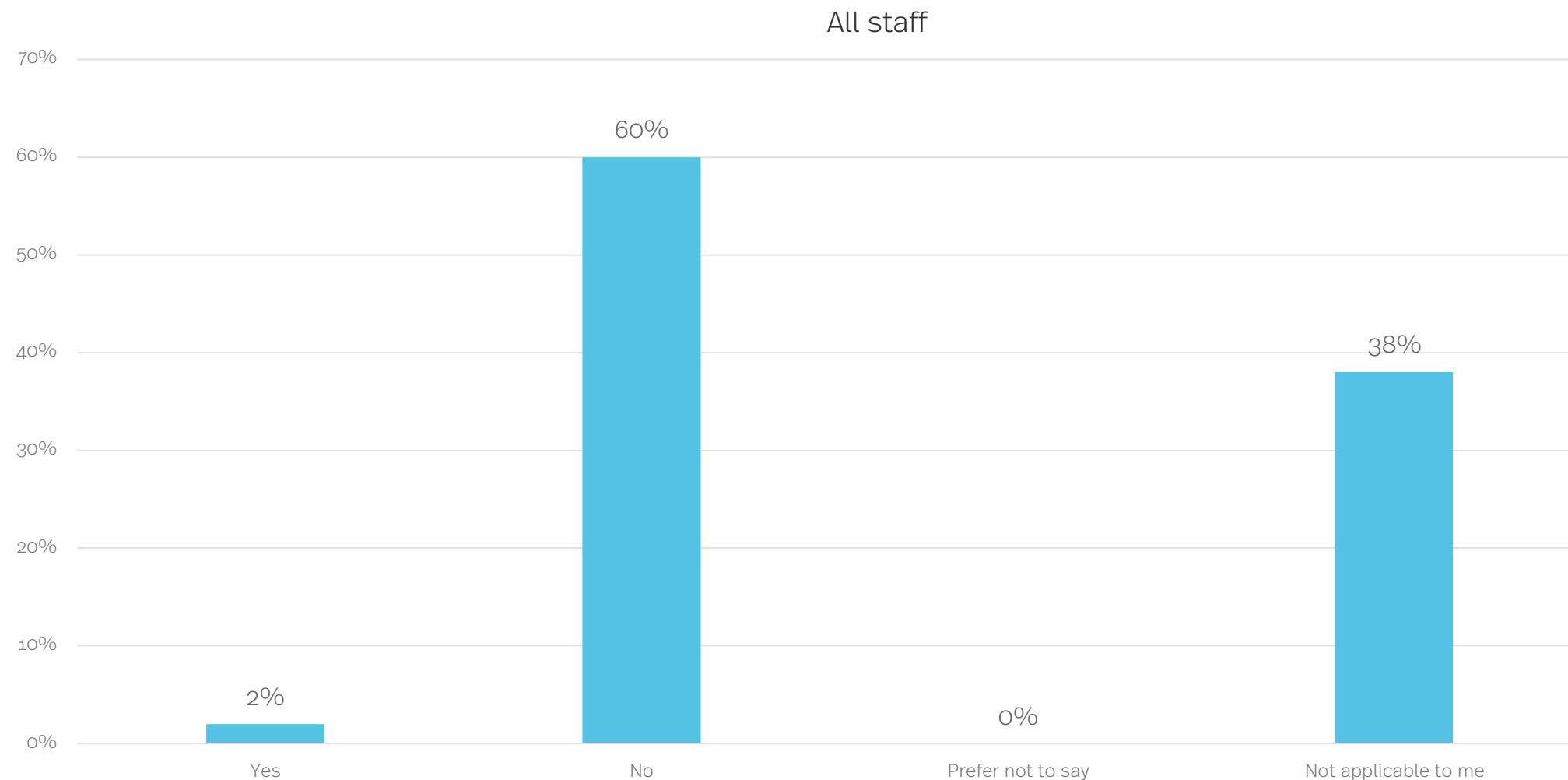


NB: The national benchmark published by the Department of Education states that 7% of the ROI population attended a fee-paying school at age 11-16 (correct as of August 2024)

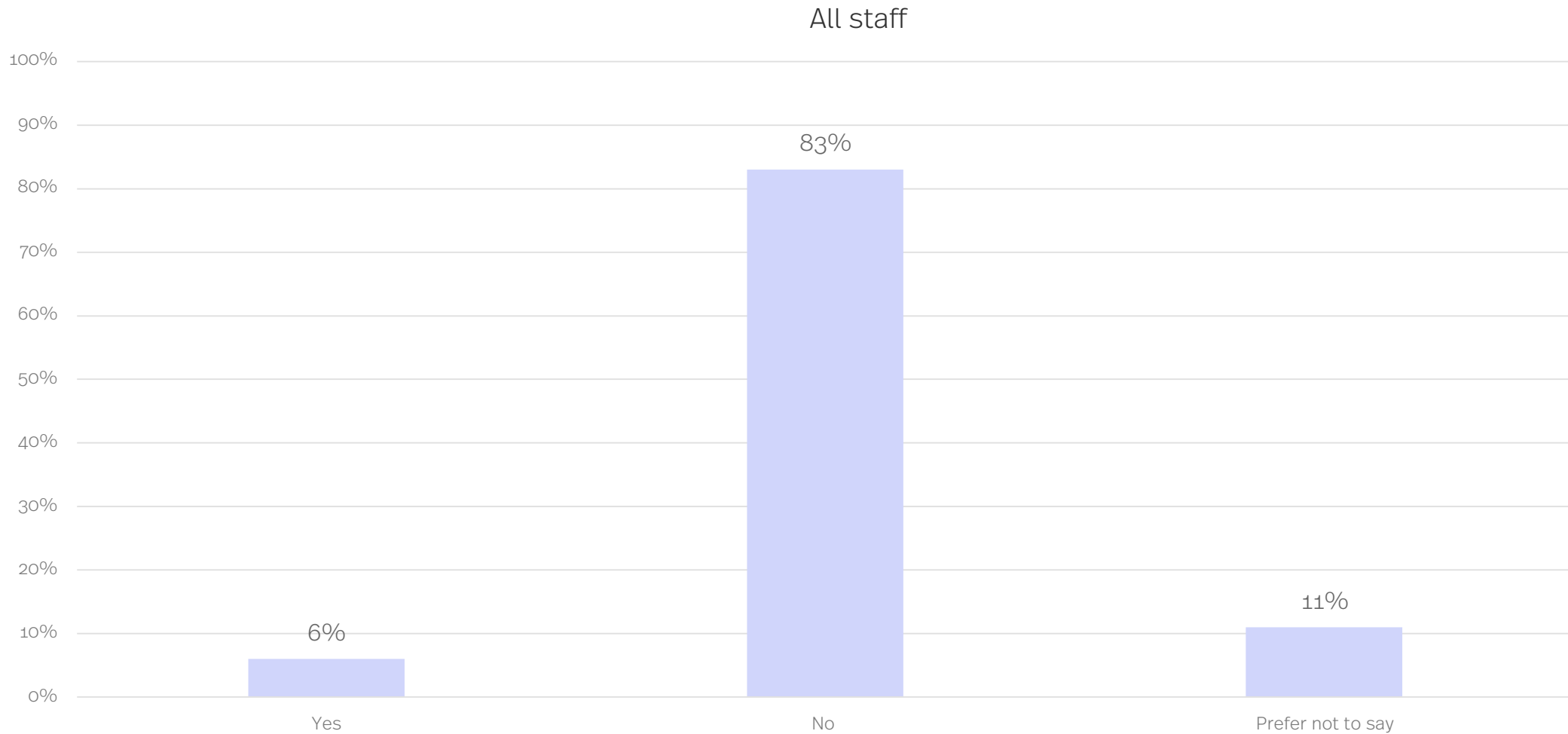


At school, did you qualify for free school meals or pupil premium?

Are you neurodiverse?

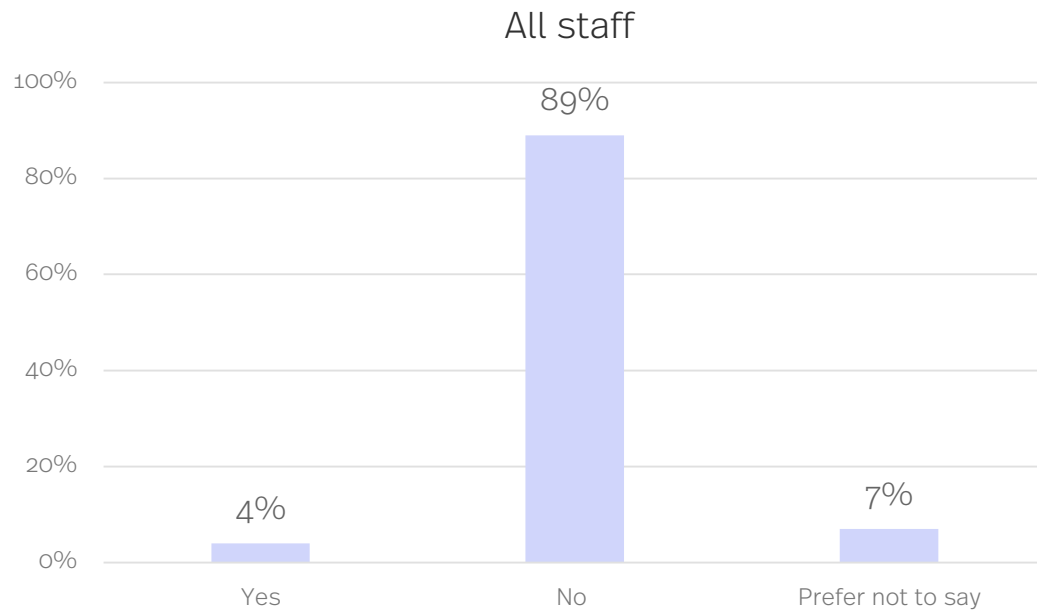


NB: Neurodiverse differences include conditions such as ADHD, Autism, Dyscalculia, and Dyslexia.

Disability

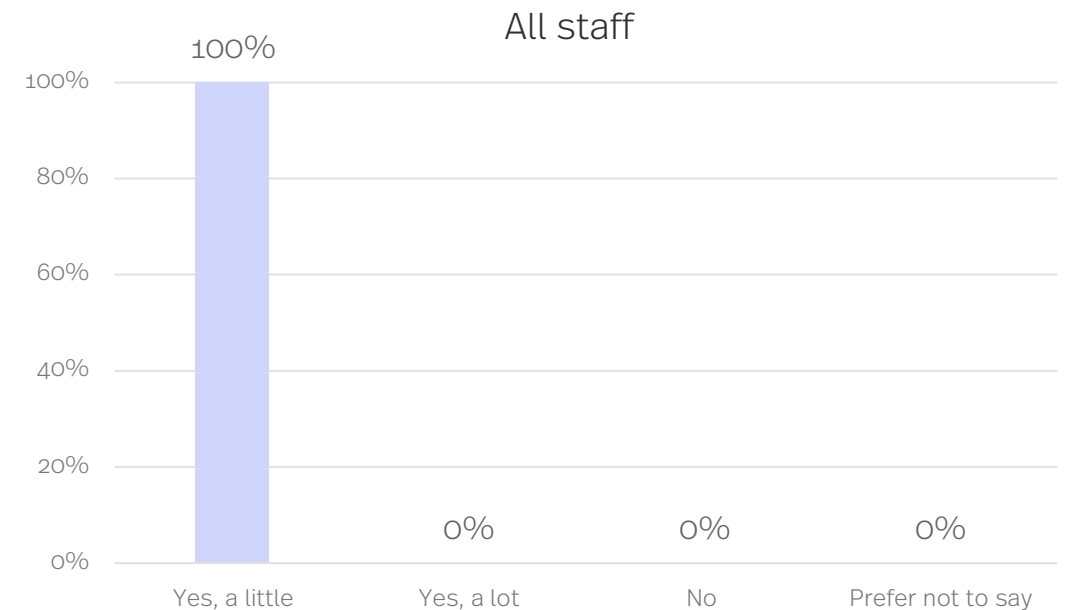


Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the UK Equality Act 2010? *



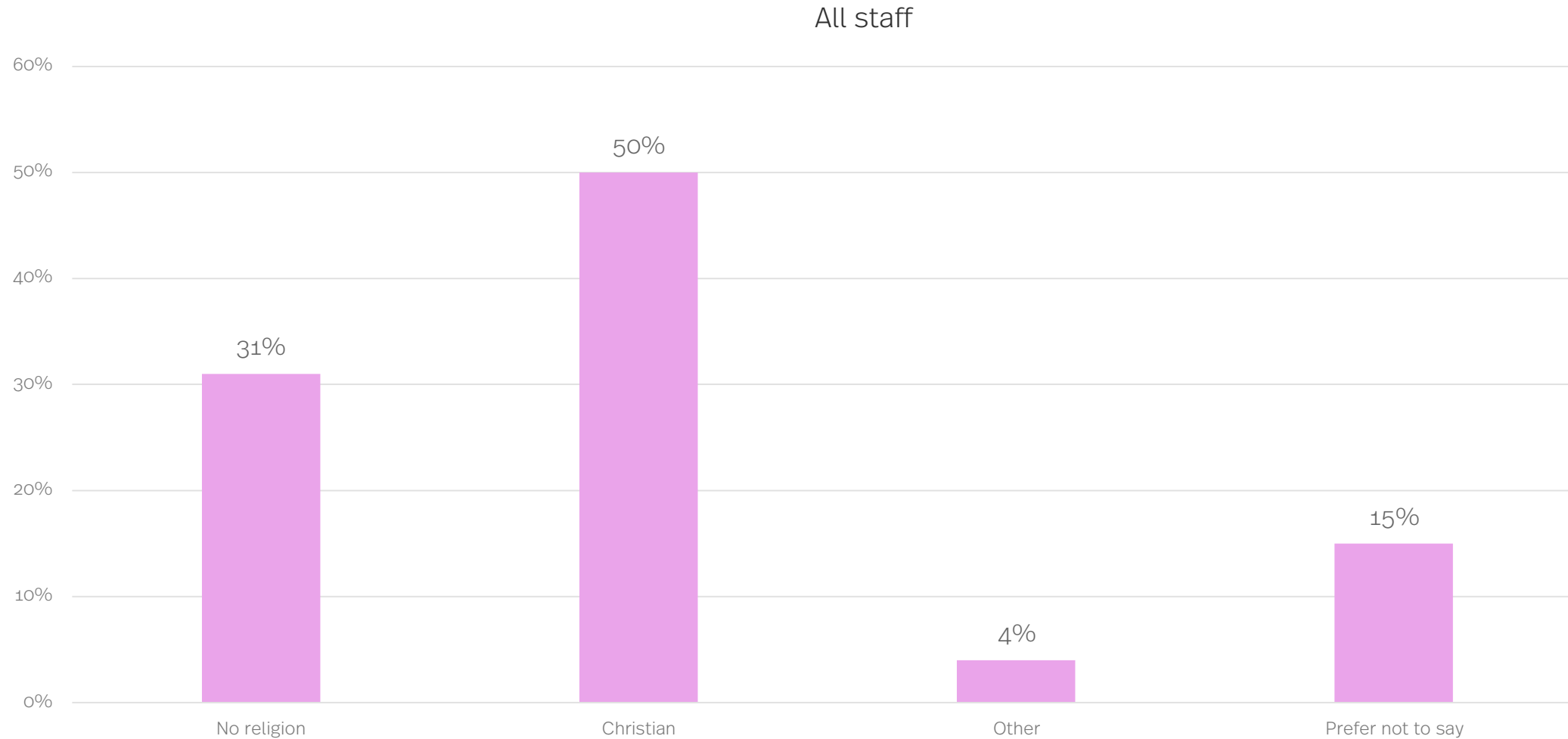

Religion or belief

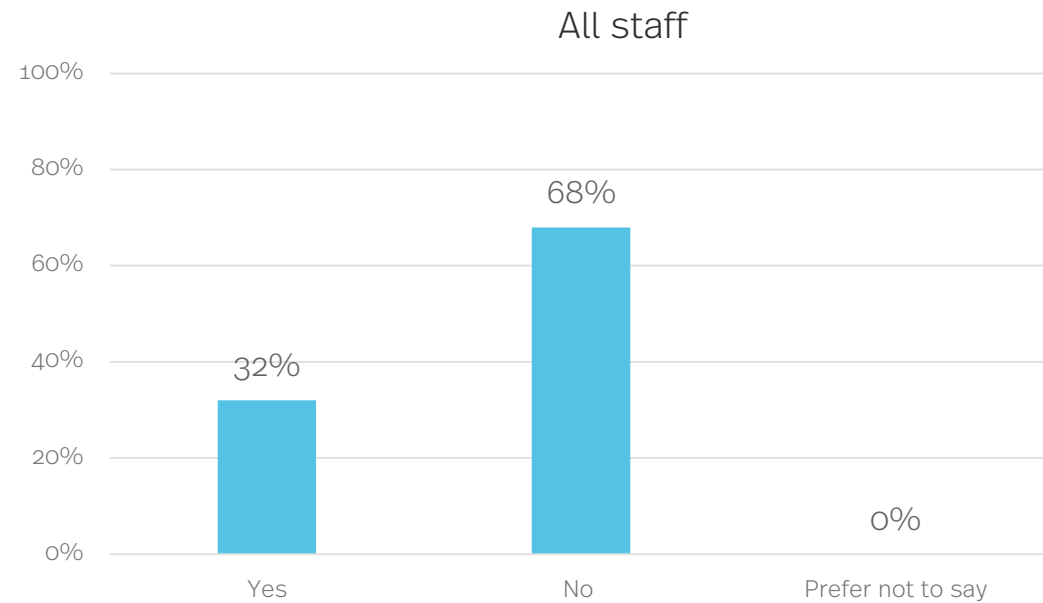
