Description: The Academic Language and Literacy Community of Practice empowers educators to enhance student engagement and provide access to rigorous content through targeted language development. This professional learning experience helps educators nurture students' backgrounds and build academic language through reading, writing, speaking, and listening scaffolds. Participants will integrate AVID's college and career readiness skills with language-building routines and strategies, promoting academic preparedness, opportunity knowledge, and student agency for multilingual learners and other learners who need language support. This course will equip educators to create equitable learning spaces that foster student voice and active participation in various academic contexts.

Description: The AVID District Director Leadership (DDL) 1: Leadership Connection Community of Practice is the first professional learning experience of the four-part District Director Leadership series. This 6-hour training establishes the foundation for the 1-year DDL professional learning journey. Participants will be introduced to the AVID College and Career Readiness Framework as a driver for AVID implementation and explore how the Continuous Improvement Cycle (Plan, Do, Study, Act) supports an increasingly impactful implementation over time. Team members will investigate the five district leadership priorities for AVID implementation (goal alignment, coaching implementation, professional learning, progress monitoring, and strategic collaboration and communication), which will be deepened and reinforced in the remainder of the DDL learning journey. The course will introduce select foundational AVID implementation resources, focusing on strategic use among AVID leaders.

Description: The AVID District Director Leadership (DDL) 2: Maximizing Roles and Responsibilities Community of Practice focuses on the specific management roles of the AVID District Director. This 12-hour training is mandatory for District Directors and optional for district leaders supporting AVID implementation. Participants will revisit the AVID College and Career Readiness Framework and five district leadership priorities for AVID implementation (goal alignment, coaching implementation, professional learning, progress monitoring, and strategic collaboration and communication), focusing on responsibilities unique to the District Director's role in managing AVID.

Description: The AVID District Director Leadership (DDL) 3: Leadership Reconnection Community of Practice instructs AVID District Directors and AVID district leadership teams to utilize the AVID College and Career Readiness Framework as a lens for supporting the site-level implementation of the AVID College and Career Readiness System. AVID district leadership teams will engage in a 12-hour training where they continue to reflect on and explore the AVID College and Career Readiness Framework to connect site implementation to district strategic plans and initiatives. Participants will utilize systems for progress monitoring and coaching as they visit AVID elementary and high school sites that demonstrate high expectations for all students using WICOR® to support rigor.

Description: The AVID District Director Leadership 4 (DDL) 4: Strategic Planning and Impact Community of Practice concludes the yearlong learning journey, focusing on deepening leadership and expansion strategies with the AVID College and Career Readiness Framework. This 12-hour training is mandatory for AVID District Directors and optional for district leaders supporting AVID implementation. The learning will focus on roles and responsibilities unique to District Directors and their direct impact on site and district leadership to ensure high-quality AVID implementation while bridging the team's ongoing work. Emphasis will be placed on strategic planning and professional learning to support AVID Schoolwide, focusing on rigorous academic preparedness, opportunity knowledge, and student agency.

Description: The Developing Critical Thinking: Computer Science Across Disciplines (PreK–12) Community of Practice, in collaboration with Amazon Future Engineer, introduces computer science concepts to educators of all subject areas. Participants will learn to use computational thinking, a problem-solving approach that breaks down complex problems into manageable parts, to support students' metacognition and problem-solving skills. This course will focus on the thinking processes of computer science applicable to students in all subject areas.

Participants will engage thoughtfully with the writing process to create and share ideas that will support deeper writing implementation in the English language arts classroom, impacting students' ability to create and effectively share knowledge and innovative ideas.

This collaborative training will engage participants in strategies and experiences that guide them in creating a school community that focuses on what students need through building relational capacity, empowering student voice, and establishing and maintaining rigorous expectations.

Description: The Foundations of Secondary Student Success Community of Practice is a foundational differentiated professional learning experience that examines instructional strategies and methodologies that support the AVID College and Career Readiness Framework and AVID Essential Skills in learning environments outside the core content areas. Educators will learn the importance of disciplinary literacy, experience WICOR® in action, and understand how to craft learning experiences that support rigorous academic preparedness, student agency, and student success skills for their specific role on campus.
