Read the Prompts Carefully

WICOR Skill: Reading

Inquire Within

WICOR Skill: Inquiry

Ask yourself powerful questions:

- What story do I want to tell?
- Why does it matter?
- What do I want others to learn from it?

Choose a story that reflects your voice, growth, and goals.

Organize Your Thoughts

WICOR Skill: Organization

Use outlines, story maps, or graphic organizers to plan your speech. Think about your beginning, middle, and end.

Builds: Opportunity Knowledge

Planning helps you communicate with purpose and make the most of this opportunity.

Collaborate for Feedback

WICOR Skill: Collaboration

Share your ideas with a peer, teacher, guardian, or mentor. Ask for feedback on your story's clarity, impact, and message. Decide what changes will strengthen your speech.

Advocate for the support you need by asking questions, seeking advice, and clarifying your ideas.

Start drafting your speech. Be bold, be clear, and be yourself. Revise and edit to make your message strong.
