The General Session connects student voice, educator practice, and leadership purpose. It is where the heart of our work comes to life. Through inspiring student performances and authentic stories from students, educators, and AVID alumni, participants explore what students need most. They learn how intentional instructional choices and systemic practices create the conditions for success for students, families, and communities.
