Participants engage with peers in similar roles, explore instructional strategies, and refine practice together, supporting implementation quality through shared language, aligned approaches, and practical application.

Communities of Practice are available for a range of roles and experience levels.

## General Session

**The General Session connects student voice, educator practice, and leadership purpose.** It is where the heart of our work comes to life. Through inspiring student performances and authentic stories from students, educators, and AVID alumni, participants explore what students need most. They learn how intentional instructional choices and systemic practices create the conditions for success for students, families, and communities.
