



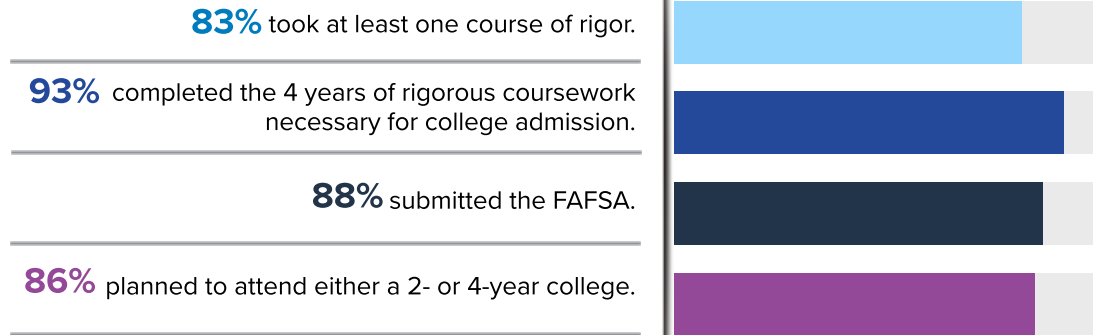

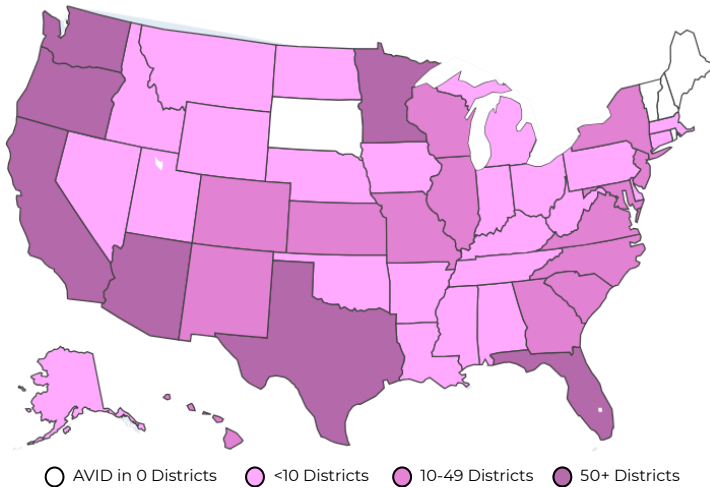
**9 out of 10** AVID seniors in the U.S. are college- and career-ready.
