

Wenceslas Square

The most important square in the New Town, Wenceslas Square is lined with historic buildings, theaters, hotels, and shops. It's also home to the National Museum, the most important museum in the country.

Architect behind Prague's "Dancing House"




Miloš Forman

Oscar-winning director of "One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest" and "Amadeus"




David Černý
