

EVENT ATTENDEE LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE

Morningstar, Inc. has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Morningstar cannot, however, guarantee that any person who attends a Morningstar in-person event will not become infected with COVID-19.

In light of the on-going spread of COVID-19, any person who falls within the categories below should not attend a Morningstar in-person event:

- Any person who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 and has not been cleared as non-contagious by their health care provider.
- Any person who currently or within the past fourteen (14) days has experienced any symptoms associated with COVID-19, which include fever, cough, and shortness of breath.
- Any person who has not received a COVID-19 vaccine – including all required doses and waiting periods generally accepted to be necessary to confer immunity – and has travelled at any point in the last fourteen (14) days to a community in the United States or abroad that is experiencing sustained community spread of COVID-19.
- Any person who has not received a COVID-19 vaccine – including all required doses and waiting periods generally accepted to be necessary to confer immunity – and has at any time in the last fourteen (14) days been exposed to a person diagnosed with or exhibiting symptoms related to COVID-19.

I acknowledge and understand that by attending a Morningstar event, I may be possibly exposed to COVID-19 at risk of serious illness or death, regardless of any preventative measures taken or not taken by Morningstar. I agree and accept these risks in order to participate in an in-person Morningstar event.

I hereby agree to waive and release Morningstar and its officers, directors, employees, agents or assigns from any and all liability arising from my attendance of any in-person Morningstar event, including but not limited to liability arising from COVID-19 or any other illness and resulting impairment or death.
