The St. James Performance Academy welcomes motivated and talented student athletes of good character who will be entering middle and high school in the fall of 2025. Applicants will be considered for grades 5 through 12 for the 2025-26 school year.

Applications are due on or before Friday, June 13, 2025. After June 13, applications will be accepted on a rolling basis.

For an application to be considered, candidates must take the following steps:



1. Submit a formal application - Students should apply using the STJ Performance Academy **online application**, which includes a candidate profile with a non-refundable \$100 application fee.



2. Submit transcript reports for the 2023-24 school year and the first semester of the 2024-25 year should be sent directly to Dr. Tere Hernandez-Acosta via email: tere.hernandez-acosta@thestjames.com.



3. Submit test Scores - Students applying to the Academy for the 2025–2026 school year are required to submit standardized test scores.



4. Attend a personal interview with an STJ Performance Academy Admissions officer – may be conducted in person or online.



5. Attend a formal athletic evaluation with an STJ Academy coach for the sport that the candidate plays and is most interested in pursuing at the Academy.

Applicants will have the ability to check the status of their formal application as well as receipt of the school-issued transcripts and standardized test scores through contact with an STJ Performance Academy Admissions officer, and the Admissions Office will send an email directly to families once all the above requirements have been met.

Please note: All applicants must demonstrate a strong command of the English language verified by our standardized testing requirement. While we welcome applications from students from all over the world, we do not have an English as a Second Language (ESL) program.
