The Loan Agreement has to start during an off-season and end during a consecutive off-season, while it can also end before the Global Free Agency but after the team has completed all of local and international matches of that Season.</p>

Callback will only be permitted in extreme circumstances such as the loaning team is not able to fulfill the roster requirement due to uncontrollable situations.

<sup>3</sup> Loan extension is allowed provided that the total loan duration does not exceed the maximum length requirement. Discussion of loan extension can happen anytime during the loan period, but the loaning team should be fully involved (it will be considered as violating Team Continuity Protection otherwise) and the extension application will only be accepted during off-seasons.
