

Axle was born prematurely as the sole survivor in a set of identical triplets. Axle began his life in The Gerber Foundation Neonatal Center at Helen DeVos Children's Hospital. He weighed in at 1 pound, 2 ounces. Eight months later, at 12 pounds, he was ready to go home.



Isaac, 11

Isaac had a heart transplant at five months old. He also has kidney disease that resulted in almost complete loss of kidney function, leading to a need for routine dialysis. Through music, play and school support provided by the child and family life team, Isaac's overall medical experience has improved.
