

One example is the Balk Family Provider Lounge, which is used daily for collaboration, relaxation and respite, community, and camaraderie. A few highlights from the past year include:

- The Office of Physician and APP Fulfillment (OPAF) has provided a wealth of resources including a lending library filled with books related to well-being, fulfillment, mitigating burnout, and diversity, equity and inclusion.
- In September, to recognize National Physician Suicide
 Day, OPAF hosted a day of listening in the lounge.
- Dr. Justin Rieth implemented the Wellness Window, a
 large flat screen monitor completely dedicated to
 displaying live, high-definition, real-time video streams
 from around the world to simulate a physical window
 with a view of the outside world. This addition to the
 space allows providers to experience real-time views of
