These programs, like those listed below, would not be available without your generosity.



Child and Family Life Art Therapy Program

A new program started in 2023, art therapy can help children communicate with caregivers, understand fears and insecurities, and better cope with the stress of their diagnosis or treatment.



NICU Family Support Program

Families receive guidance such as sibling groups to help normalize the NICU environment, parentto-parent dinners, and lunchtime lactation support groups.



Injury Prevention Initiatives

This team works with patients and families to provide car seat education, offers inperson and virtual car seat classes, and holds community car seat check events throughout the year.



Dick and Linda Antonini Hospital School Program

The school program is available to bridge the gap between schools, families, and the medical team, provide educational opportunities during treatment, and maintain involvement in normal routines.

She went through chemo, stem cell collection, two bone marrow transplants, radiation, and five rounds of immunotherapy. Thanks to the personalized care she received at Helen DeVos Children's Hospital, Anna is in remission.

Beckett, 1

Shorty after Beckett was born, he was rushed to Helen DeVos Children's Hospital for high blood sugar and a fever. After staying in the NICU for nine days, Beckett was diagnosed with neonatal diabetes. Thanks to the quick diagnosis, Beckett is thriving and meeting all milestones.

Everett, 7

Everett has faced numerous medical challenges from birth, including frequent focal seizures. After finding a suitable treatment, Everett underwent a hemispherectomy, disconnecting the left side of his brain. Despite ongoing challenges, Everett's resilience has allowed him to regain his identity and make strides towards a brighter future.

Lorenzo, 12

Lorenzo was born with cystic fibrosis, a disorder that affects the lungs and digestive tract. Lorenzo's family transferred his care to Helen DeVos Children's Hospital because of their great reputation and how close it was to home. After six years of receiving care at HDVCH, Lorenzo and his parents consider the hospital staff family.
