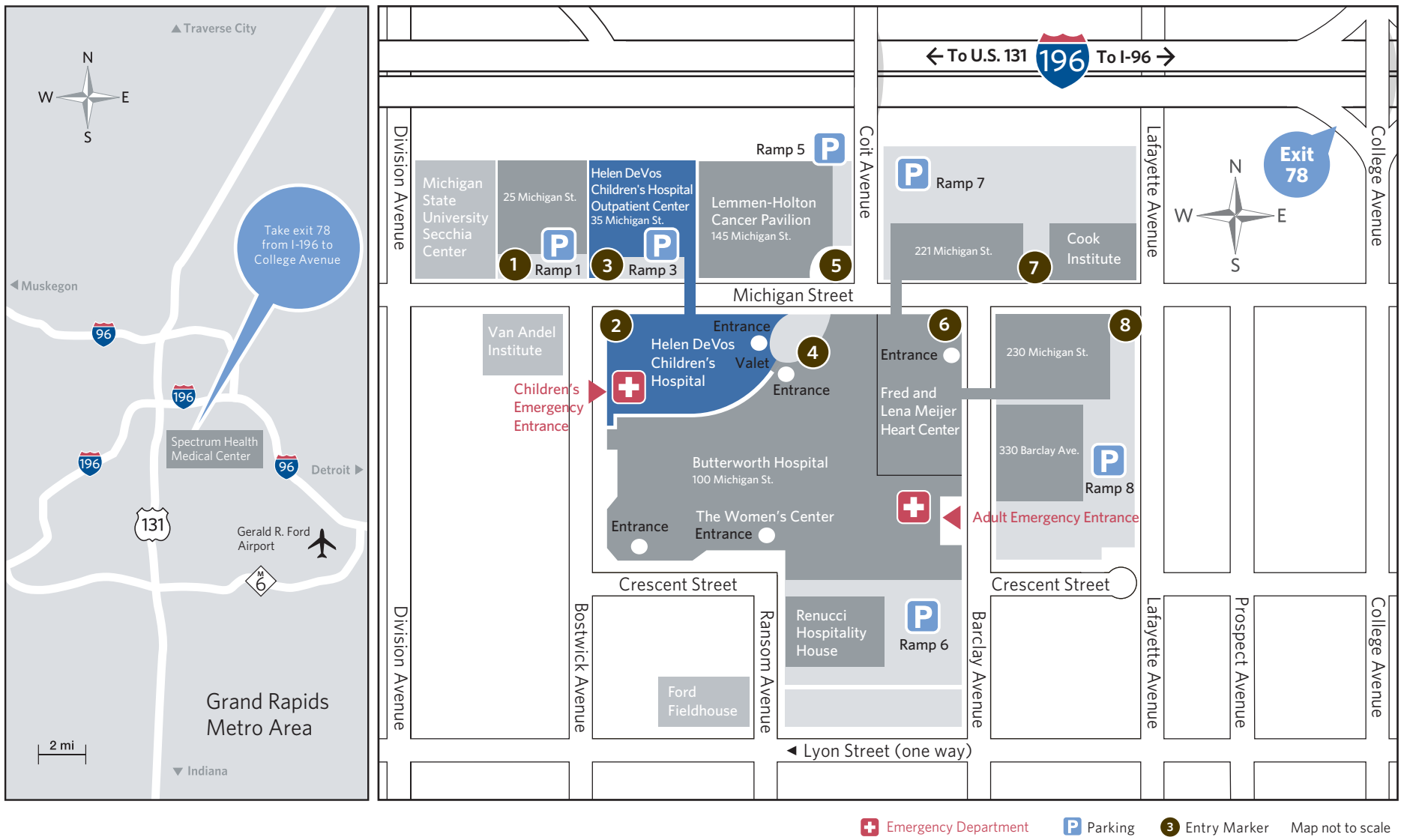

Driving Directions

1. Coming from the north or south, take US-131 toward Grand Rapids to I-196 East. Coming from the east or west take I-196 toward Grand Rapids.
2. Exit on College Avenue (Exit 78) and turn south.
3. Turn right on Michigan Street (first traffic light).
4. The hospital is located on the left side of Michigan Street, past the corner of Michigan Street and Barclay Avenue. Parking Ramp 3 is located on the right side of Michigan Street.

When You Get Here

Parking Information

2 Emergency Parking

If you are coming to the hospital because of an emergency, free valet parking is available at the children's emergency department entrance at the corner of Bostwick Avenue and Michigan Street.

Parking

You may either use valet parking (for a fee) or should park in Ramp 3.

3 Ramp 3

The entrance to Ramp 3 is on the north side of Michigan Street (near the corner of Bostwick Avenue and Michigan Street). Follow the signs and park in one of the Spectrum Health designated parking spots. Bring your parking ticket with you to the hospital or to your appointment, so we can validate it for free parking. If you forget to bring your ticket with you, please inform one of our employees.

4 Hospital Valet Parking

Valet parking (for a fee) is available at the circular drive main entrance on Michigan Street. Valet parking is free for vehicles with handicap tags or handicap license plates.

Valet hours:

Monday to Friday, 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Saturday, Sunday and holidays, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

After you park, take the blue '35' elevator to Level 3. You will cross Michigan Street on the pedestrian bridge to enter the main lobby of the hospital. In the hospital you will find children's emergency department, sedation services, pediatric radiology, surgery check in and operating rooms, the Gerber Foundation Neonatal Center, patient rooms, pediatric hematology/oncology/BMT, epilepsy monitoring unit (overnight), pediatric intensive care unit and pediatric cardiac intensive care unit.

25 Michigan Street

After you park, take the red '25' elevator to the lobby, then cross and take the elevator to Floor 3, 4 or 5. In 25 Michigan Street you will find the Congenital Heart Center, genetics and maternal fetal medicine.

35 Michigan Street

After you park, take the blue '35' elevator to Floor 1, 3, 4 or 5.

Floor 3

Neurodevelopmental pediatrics, outpatient lab/draw station, pediatric allergy & immunology, pediatric neurology, outpatient EEG, pediatric neurosurgery, pediatric pulmonary & sleep medicine (including sleep studies), pediatric bio-chemical genetics

Floor 4

Pediatric orthopedics, pediatric gastroenterology, pediatric rheumatology, pediatric infectious disease, outpatient pediatric rehab

Floor 5

Pediatric & Family Optical, pediatric behavioral health, pediatric ophthalmology, pediatric neuropsychology, pediatric pain & palliative medicine, pediatric plastic surgery & dermatology, pediatric psychology, pediatric psychiatry

330 Barclay Avenue

8 Ramp 8

For offices located in 330 Barclay Avenue, park in Ramp 8.

The entrance to Ramp 8 is on the south side of Michigan Street (across from Ramp 7). Bring your parking ticket with you to your appointment, so we can validate it for free parking.

In 330 Barclay Avenue you will find academic general pediatrics, adolescent & young adult medicine and the injury prevention program.

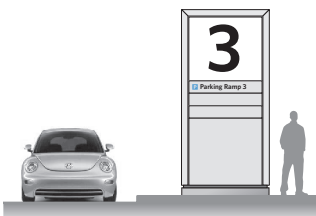
