The following information describes each arrangement for which our ACO seeks protection under the ACO Pre-Participation Waiver, including any material amendment or modification to a disclosed arrangement.

**Application and Operational Services:**

- Parties to the arrangement: ACO, ACO participants, ACO providers/suppliers, affiliated health system (Spectrum Health, now Corewell Health System), other affiliated entities (Answer Health), and vendors providing services to the ACO.
- Date of arrangement: The twelve months leading up to July 1, 2019.
- Items, services, goods, or facility provided: The ACO entered into an arrangement pursuant to which Spectrum Health System (now Corewell Health System) provided all funding for the administrative services, management services, and information technology necessary to apply for, and successfully participate in, the MSSP. Under this arrangement the ACO participants agreed to participate in the ACO and MSSP and Spectrum Health, now Corewell Health System (an affiliated health system) and Answer Health (an affiliated entity) agreed to provide in-kind services to and for the ACO and other ACO participants. This arrangement included the formation and capitalization of the ACO, and the development of the ACO operating agreement and participation agreements.
- Date and nature of any amendments to the arrangement, if applicable: None.

**ACO Participation Waiver:****Operational Services:**

- Parties to the arrangement: ACO, ACO participants, ACO providers/suppliers, affiliated health system (Spectrum Health, now Corewell Health System), other affiliated entities (Answer Health and Lakeland Care Network beginning on 1/1/2022), and vendors providing services to the ACO.
- Date of arrangement: July 1, 2019
- Items, services, goods, or facility provided: The ACO participants and/or their parent or other affiliated company provide funding for, or in-kind, administrative services, items, and personnel; management services, items, and personnel; other operational services, items, and personnel; facilities; and information technology services, items, software, and personnel that are necessary to successfully participate in the MSSP. Under this arrangement such items, services, personnel, and facilities are provided to and for the benefit of the ACO, ACO participants, and ACO providers/suppliers. Each of the parent or other affiliated companies provide an approximate pro rata share of such items, services, goods, and facilities to the ACO.
- Date and nature of any amendments to the arrangement, if applicable: None.

**Post-Acute Care Navigation Services:**

- Parties to the arrangement: ACO, ACO participants, and affiliated health system (Corewell Health System)
- Date of arrangement: March 16, 2022.
- Items, services goods, or facility provided: Under this arrangement the affiliated health system (Corewell Health System) provides post-acute care navigation services to the patients of ACO

participants, providers, and suppliers. Such care navigation services include the provision of post-acute care navigation care personnel (e.g.: post-acute care coordinators and care managers), post-acute care management software, and other related services.
