


SECONDARY (INTERMEDIATE) COLOR WHEEL

Directions: Place the PRIMARY COLORS in the circles and the SECONDARY COLORS in the squares.




SECONDARY (INTERMEDIATE) COLOR WHEEL

TERTIARY (INTERMEDIATE) COLOR WHEEL




