



1. Print out pages 4, 5 and 6 on HP Brochure Paper 180g (cardstock).

Cut out the pieces (the card, the house, the roof, the snow base and the trapezoidal support) and fold all the pieces on the dash lines.




3. Take one of the house piece and apply glue on the tab.



4. Attach the second house piece.




5. Glue the tabs on the house together to make a box shape.




6. This is what your gingerbread house should look like.



7. Glue the top tabs together to make an interior support. This will make sure the house maintains its shape.




8. Make sure the house folds flat nicely.




9. Take your trapezoidal support piece and glue to your interior tabs.






10. Apply glue to the tabs on one side of the roof.



11. Glue the roof to the house making sure the tabs are on the underside of the house. Make sure the indent in the roof matches with the chimney side of the house.



12. Glue the other side of the roof to the house. (Again, make sure the house folds nicely with the roof attached.)



13. Flip your house upside down and apply glue to the trapezoidal piece.




14. Match the trapezoidal piece to the light gray tab printed on the snow base and glue down.



15. Apple glue to the tabs on the bottom of the house and match to the other two light gray tabs on the snow base.





16. Glue the snow base to the card making sure the center fold matches up.




17. Close and open the card to make sure the pop-up effect works.

18. Decorate the front of the card and write a message!














- 1. Print out pages 3 and 4 on HP Brochure Paper 180g (cardstock).
- 2. Cut out the fireplace pop-up card and the blue background. Fold the blue background in half on the dash lines and set aside.



3. On the fireplace pop-up card, use a craft knife and cut the inside of the fireplace.



4. With the craft knife cut the black solid lines on the left and right sides of the fireplace.



5. Next, fold on the dash lines.



6. Keep folding on all the dash lines.




6. This is what your fireplace card should look like.





7. Apply double-sided tape or glue to the back of the card and stick onto the blue background.



8. Decorate the front of the card and write a message!













1. Print out pages 3 and 4 on HP Brochure Paper 180g (cardstock).





3. Fold the card in half and set aside.



4. Fold all the snowmen in half




5. Stack the snowmen so they are all facing the same direction (color side up).



6. Apply glue on just the spine.



6. Adhere to the other snowman. Glue the last snowman - making sure the snowman on top has the face printed on it.



7. Glue the bottom of the stacked snowman spine to the interior fold of the card making sure to line it up with the snowman illustration.



8. Decorate the front of the card and write a message!
