



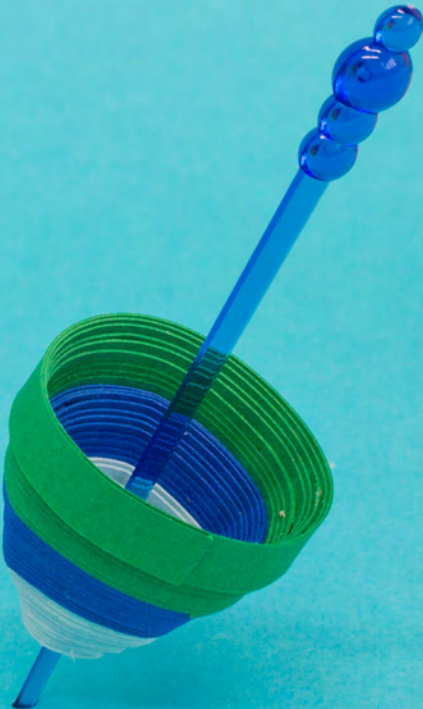


PAPER DREIDEL SPIN TOPS

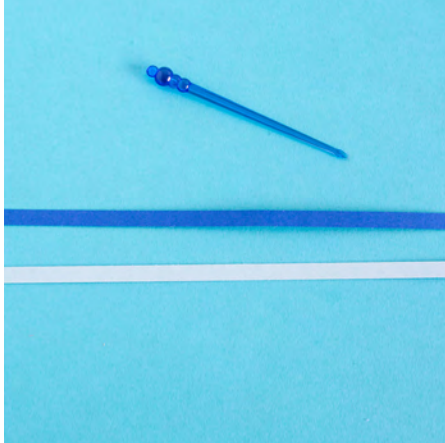

	Toothpicks

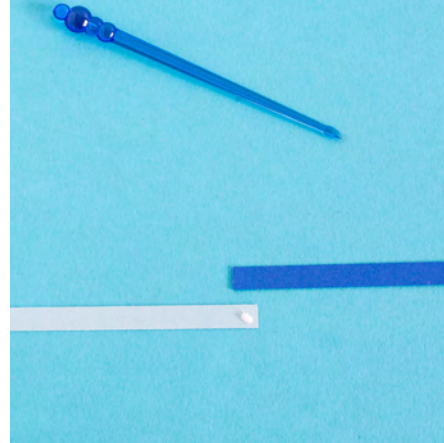


PAPER DREIDEL SPIN TOPS

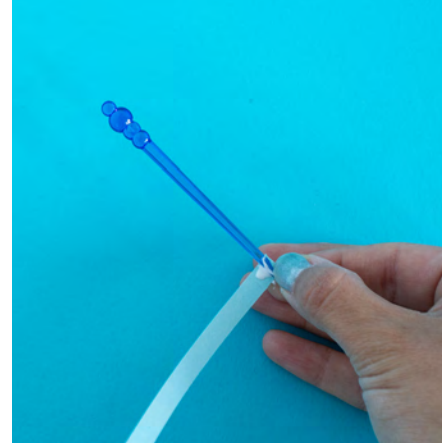
INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Cut the strips of colored paper.



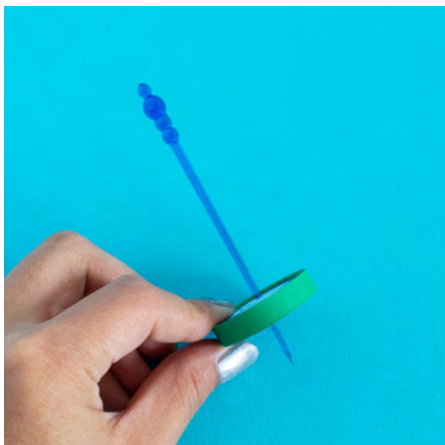
2. Glue the edge of one strip to a second strip of paper. Continue with the remaining strips until you have one long continuous piece of paper.



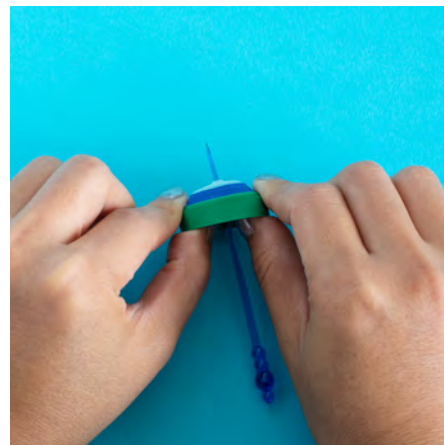
3. Glue the end of the long strip to the toothpick. The paper should be a little bit above the tapered point. Let dry.



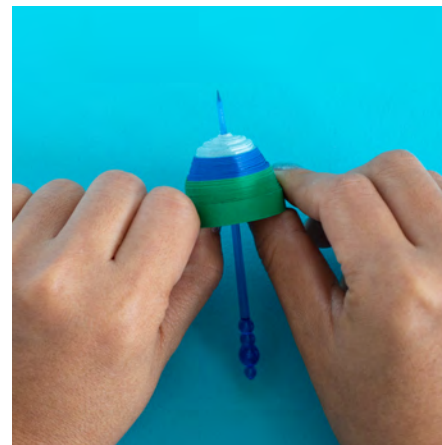
4. Roll the long strip of paper tightly around the toothpick. Keep going until you reach the end and glue down.



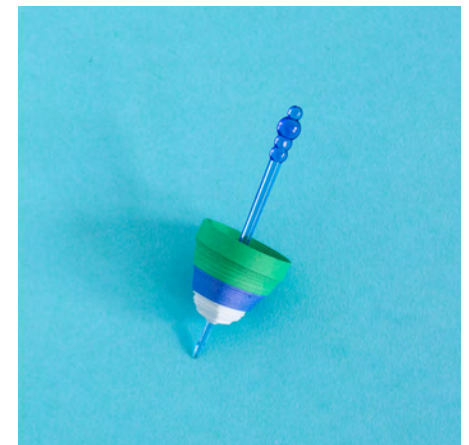
5. Your dreidel should now look like this.



6. Using your thumbs, push the disc of paper downwards toward the toothpick point to create a bowl shape.




7. Keep shaping the paper disc until you get your desired dreidel shape.






8. Spin and enjoy!

PAPER DREIDEL SPIN TOPS

TIP: You can print page 2 for your strips or cut your own out of colored paper.
A symmetrical toothpick works best for spinning.
