Yulia Peresild and Klim Shipenko were joined by professional <u>cosmonaut</u> Anton Shkaplerov for the big launch to their new movie location – the International Space Station (ISS).

The trio will spend 12 days on board filming <u>scenes</u> for a new movie called *The Challenge*. The story is all about a surgeon (played by Yulia) who is sent to the ISS to help save a cosmonaut who has fallen ill.

Yulia had to <u>undergo</u> four months of training for the out-ofthis-world project, which will also see guest appearances from some other cosmonauts currently working on the ISS. 
