





## Pin the Tail on the Bunny



## How-to:



Step 1

Print out all three pages of the printable and trim off the white paper edges. You can print off extra copies of the grassy fields if you want your poster to cover a bigger area. Tape up the posters onto the wall.



Step 2

To make the pom pom tails, cut a double layer of tissue paper into a 9" by 4" rectangle. Fold it lengthwise so that you now have a folded 9" by 2" rectangle. Use scissors to cut 1" snips into the unfolded edge every  $\frac{1}{2}$ " or so.



Step 3

Apply a thin line of glue along the top and roll the tissue paper up so that it looks like a tassel. Give the tissue paper fringe a gentle crumple with your hand so that it looks like a round little bunny tail.



Step 4

Make as many pom poms as needed for gameplay, making them in various colors to differentiate between players. When ready to play, apply a piece of tape to the little top of the tissue paper pom pom for sticking onto the poster.
