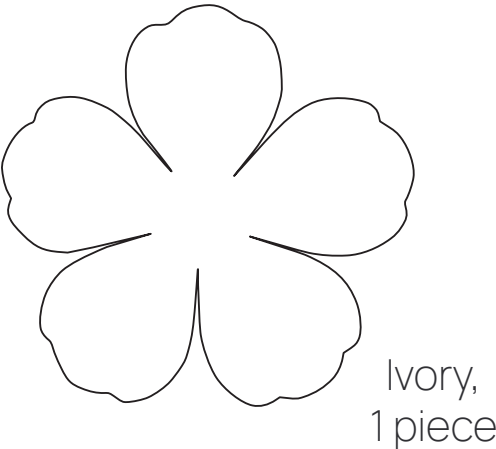
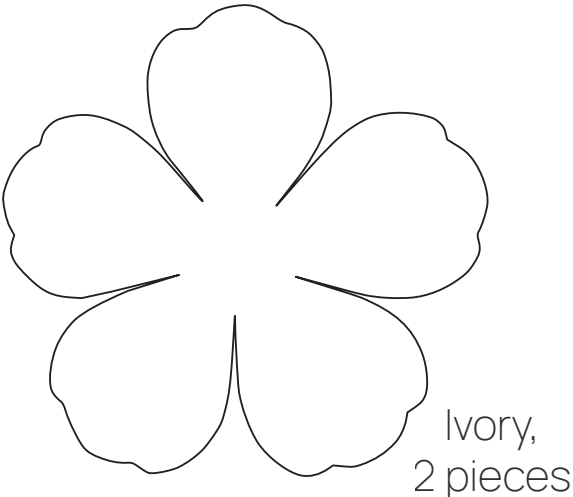
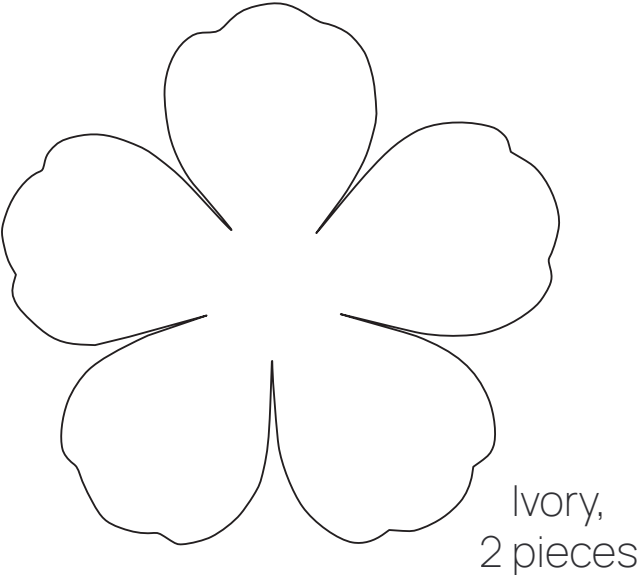
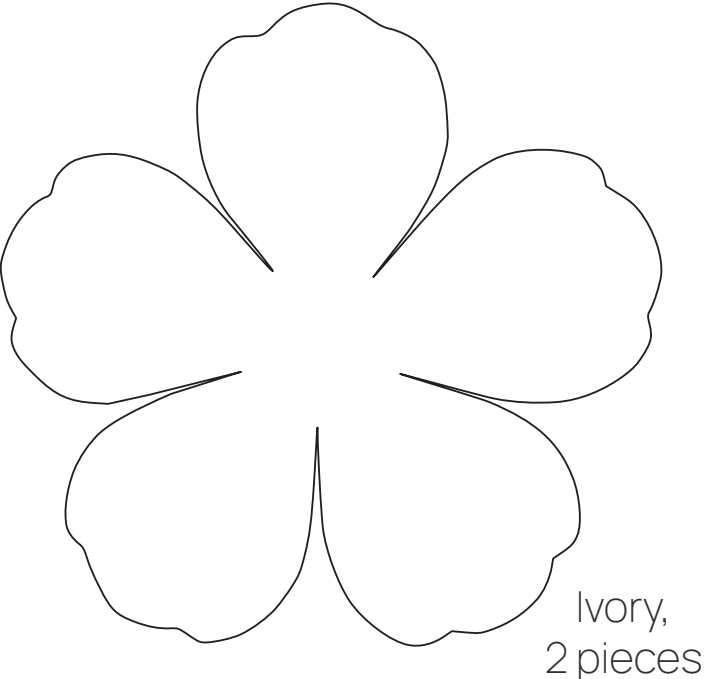
- Black cardstock

- You can trace these and cut them out of stronger card if you prefer.



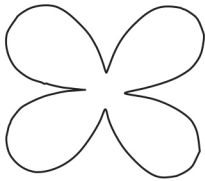

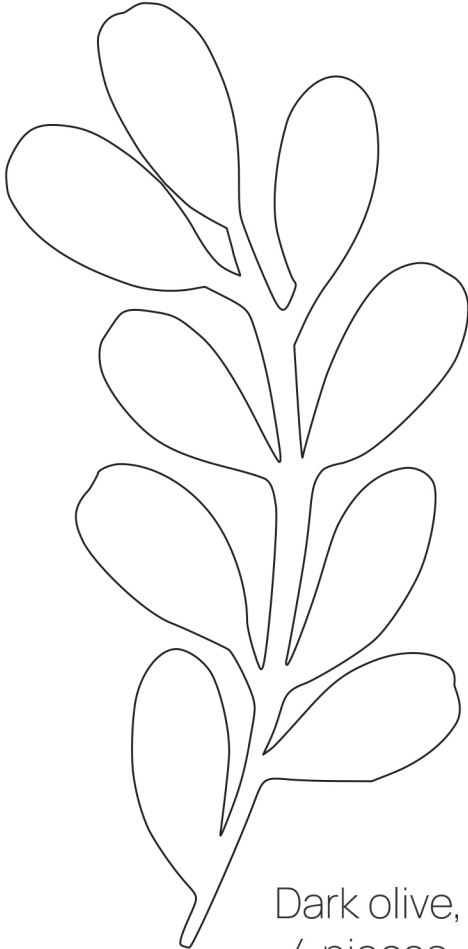

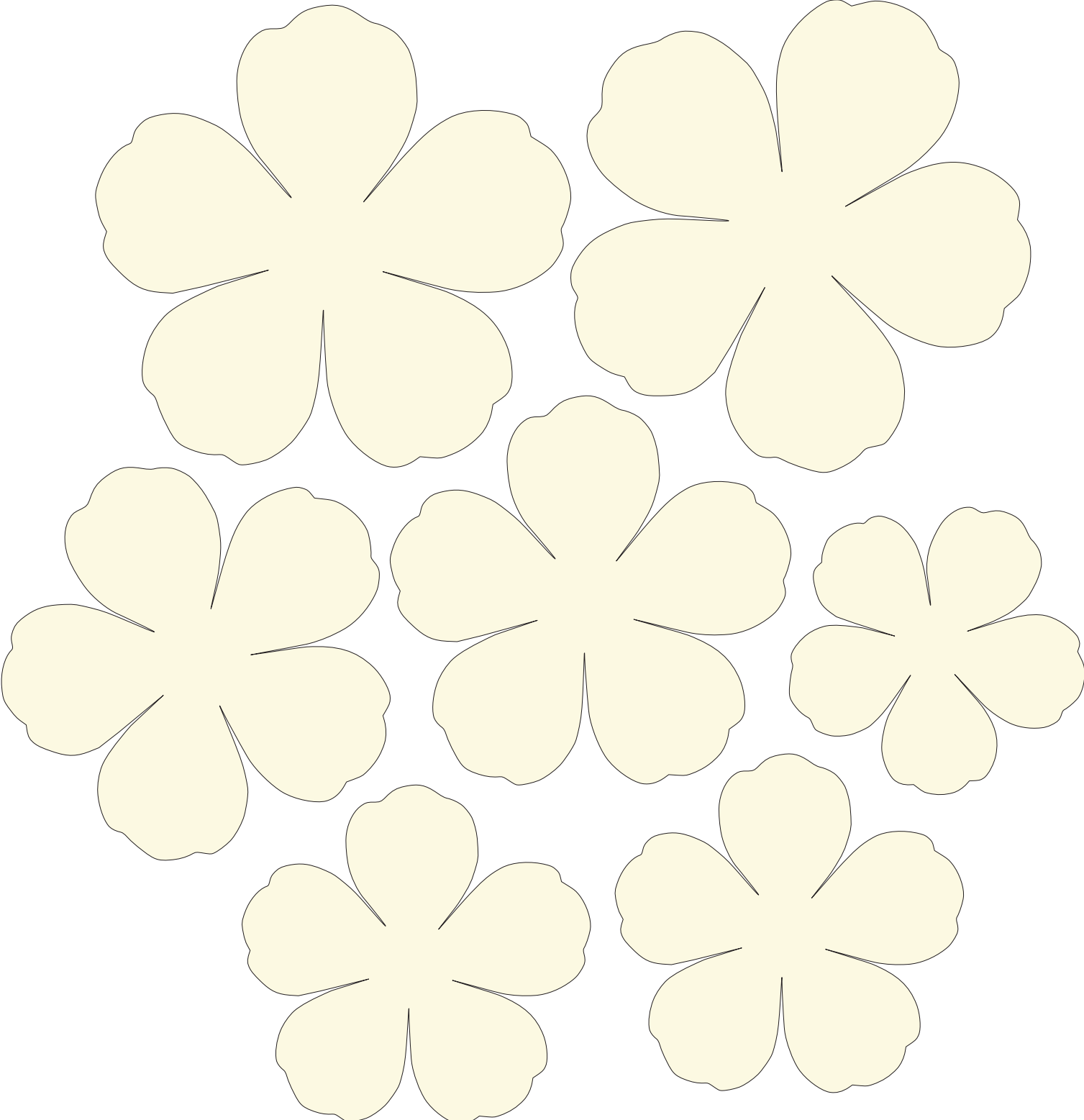

If you don't have colored paper you can print the colored details on white paper.

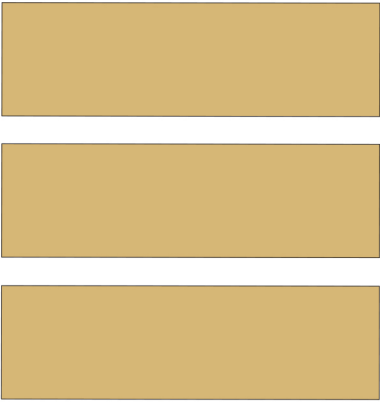
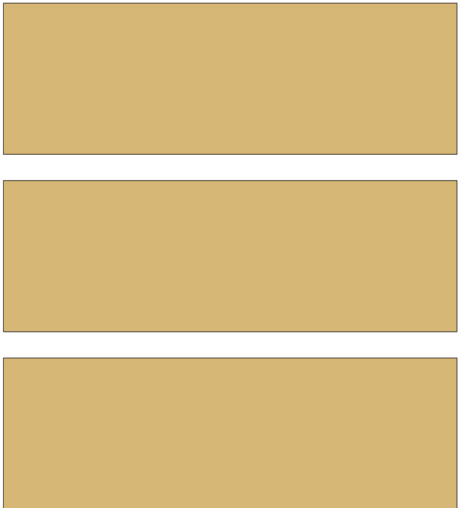
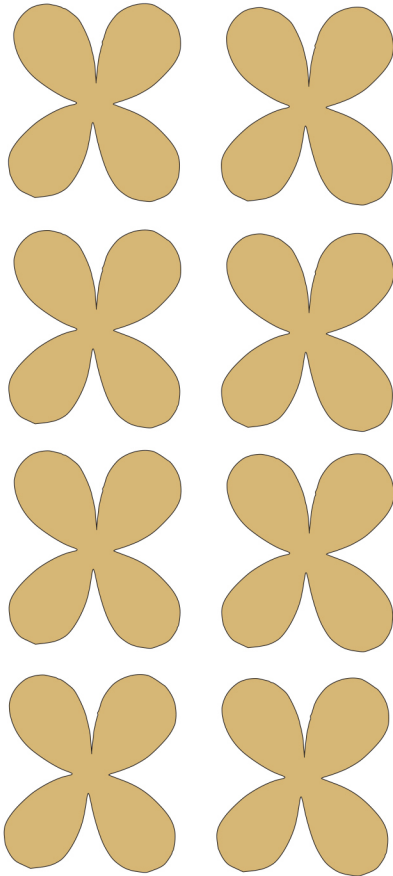

Curl petals with edge of scissors.



Fold petals.



Shape flowers by gluing parts.



Cut the stripes to get the fringe.

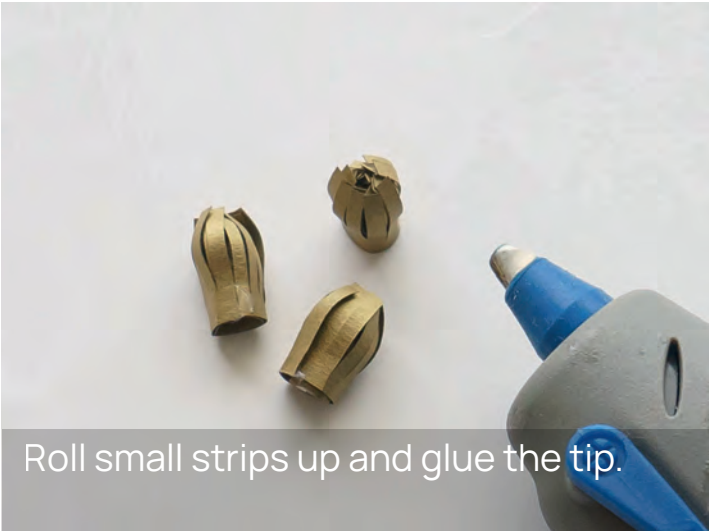


Curl it with edge of scissors.
