

GRADUATION photo frame

The perfect way to jazz up a formal graduation photo and celebrate your achievements!



Print this design out, preferably onto card stock or thicker paper.

The template is made for a standard 6x4" photo but you can scale it up or down to fit a different size using your printer settings.

Cut the inside of the frame first to make it less fiddly.

Either use a scalpel and a cutting mat, or make a hole with the point of your scissors and then guide them round the inner shape.

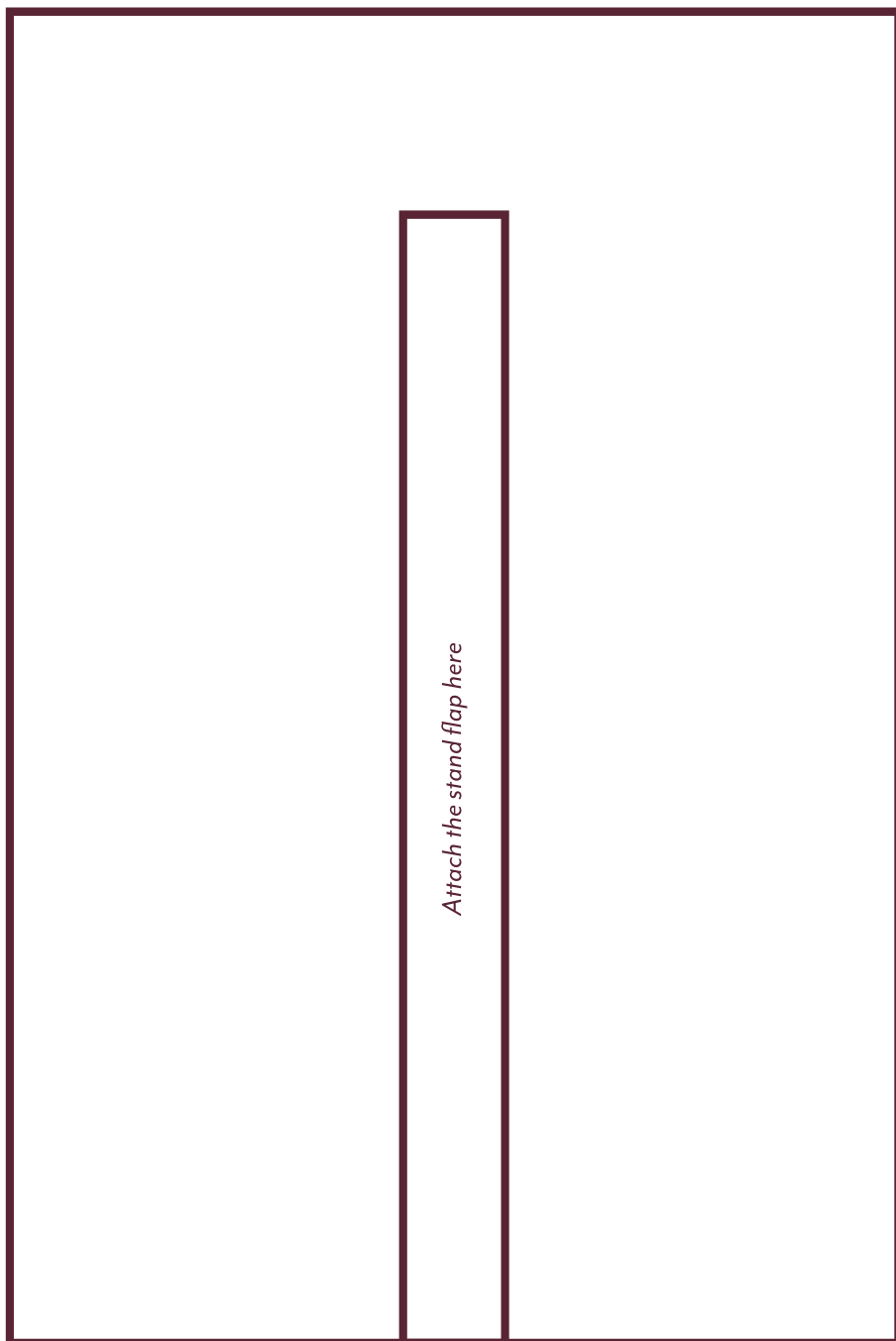
Cut around the outside edge of the illustration.

Feel free to go as close to the design as you like, or leave a white edge for a different effect.

Cut out the stand and the backing rectangle below. Insert your graduation photo to sit nicely in the frame, then glue or use double-sided tape to attach the the edge of the rectangle to the back of the frame and the photo.

Fold the dotted line on the stand and glue or tape one edge to the marked space on the rectangle to allow the frame to stand. Display with pride - conGRADulations!
