#4 Sleigh Tree Ornament



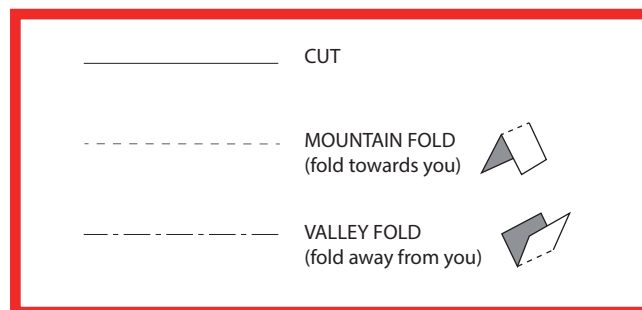

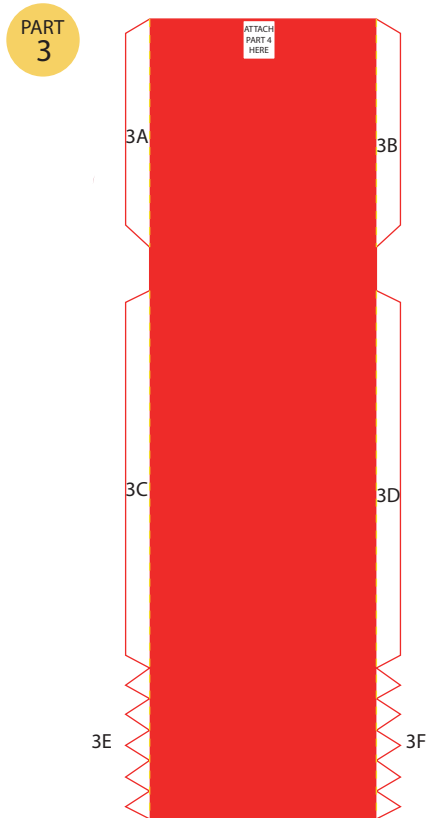
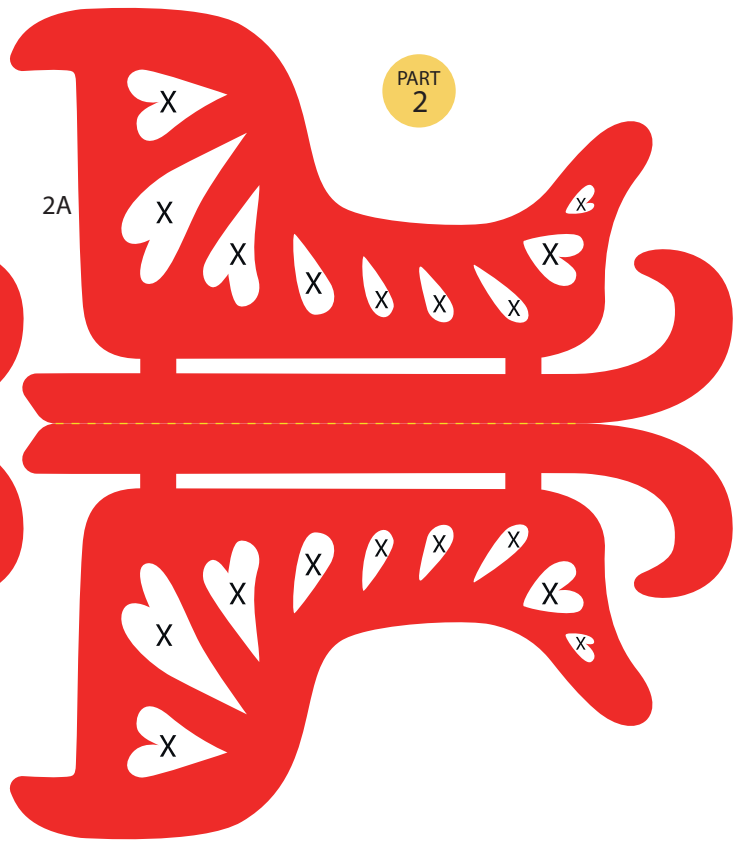
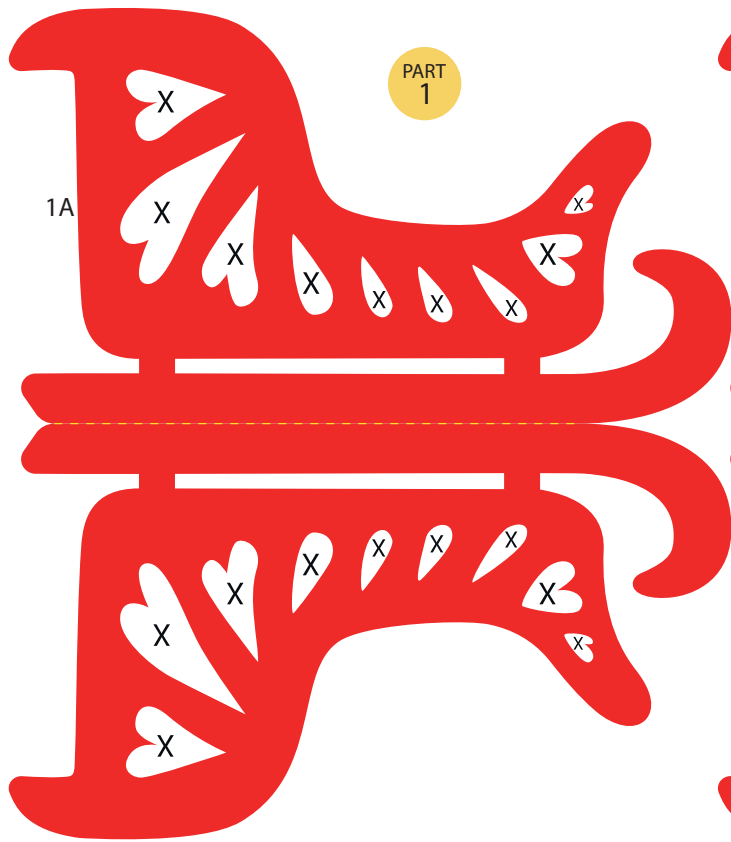

#4 Sleigh Tree Ornament instructions

- 1 Cut out all parts. Use a craft knife for best results. Also cut out the internal shapes marked with an X on parts 1 & 2.
2. Carefully fold along all fold lines (see key). Before folding it is recommended to score the line lightly with a craft knife or a ballpoint pen that no longer has ink in it. This will make folding easier and more precise.
3. Take part 1 and fold in half along the marked line so that the red printed side is on the outside and the cut out shapes line up. Glue together.
4. Repeat this action with part 2 so that you have two double sided sleigh shapes.
5. Take part 3. This will join the two sleigh shapes together and form the seat of the sleigh. Glue tabs 3A & 3B to the insides of the back of the sleigh (sides 1A & 2A) so that the red colour is on the outside and the tabs point inwards. Make sure part 3 is lined up with the back line.
6. Bend part 3 around, following the bottom edge of the sleigh to form the seat and glue in place using tabs 3C-3F.
7. Take one of the part 4 strips and bend around so that the 2 ends meet and the red colour is on the outside. Do the same with the other strip, but have the red colour on the inside. Then glue the inner strip to the outer strip so that you have red colour on both sides. Glue the two ends together to form a loop and then glue it to the marked tab on part 3.
8. Glue part 5 onto the white side of part 3 to complete.
