
The ABC Phonics chart can be used:

- For students who are at the beginning stages of letter recognition, have them say the name of the letters, "A is for apple, a, a, a." This allows them to practice with Capital and lowercase letters.
- For students who are learning letter sounds, have them say "A is for apple, /a/, /a/.
- As students progress, the ABC Phonics chart can be cut up and used as a puzzle. The teacher will say, "I'm looking for a letter that sounds like /w/. The student would find the correct strip.






