



BEARD DISGUISE

Inspired by *Creepy Cafetorium*



What's better than a room full of magical books? How about meeting mystical author Julian Cheesecloth, who is definitely not Gertie with a fake pointy beard. Make your own totally convincing beard disguise, then give your hairy self a silly name! (Not that Gertie would know anything about that...)

YOU'LL NEED:

- Pencil
- Cardboard or heavy paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Cotton balls
- Hole punch
- String or elastic

1. Use a pencil to draw your beard on a piece of cardboard. Make sure to include a hole for your mouth, as shown. Ask a grown-up to help you cut out your beard.
2. Glue cotton balls to one side of the cardboard, as shown.
3. Use a hole punch to make a hole on each side of your beard. Thread a 12-inch piece of string or elastic through the holes, and tie a knot at each end, as shown.
4. Put on your beard, and have that new name ready for when people don't recognize your hairy face!



Your beard can be pointy, bushy, or even a goatee!

For a long, stringy beard, glue pieces of yarn or strips of colored paper to the cardboard instead.
