- 3 Creative Writing Prompts

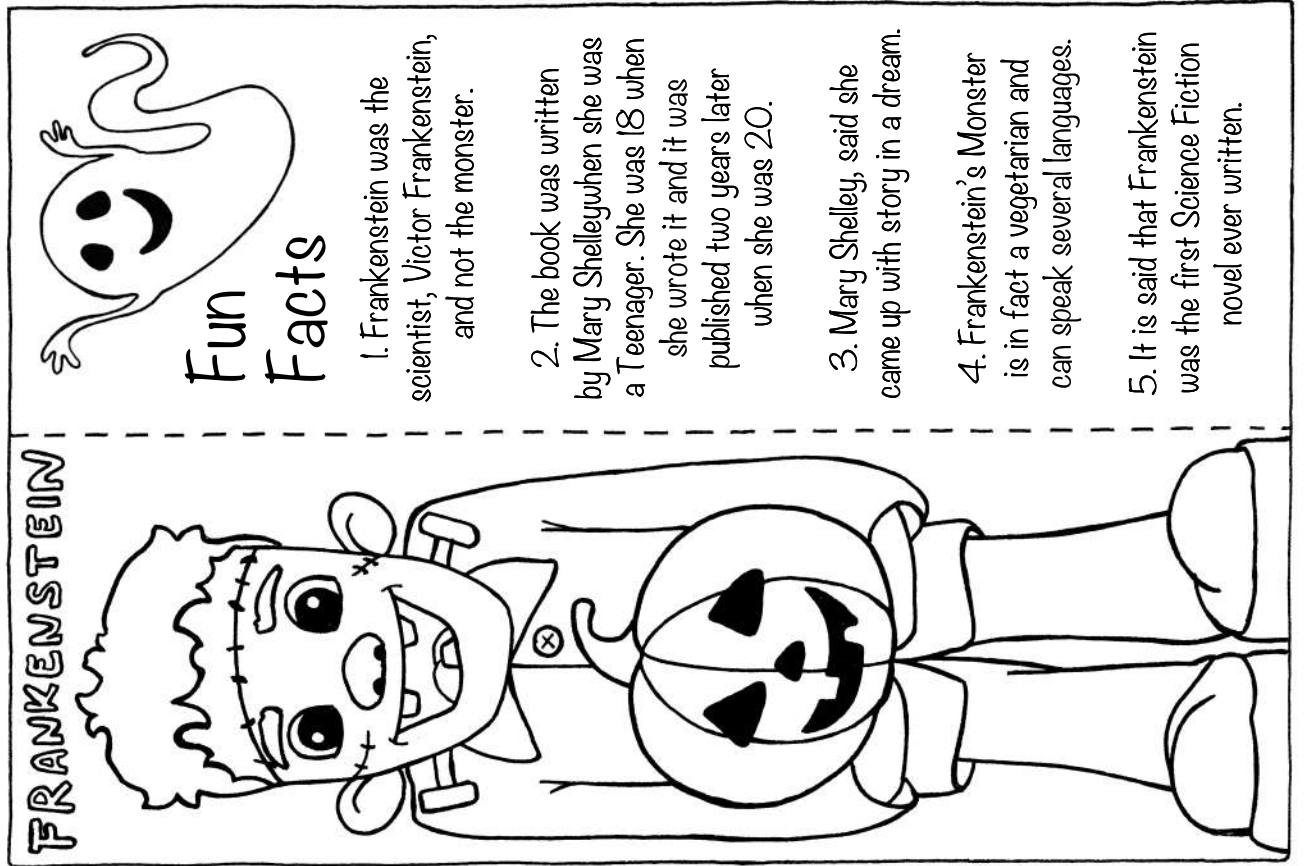


Educational benefits of these activities:

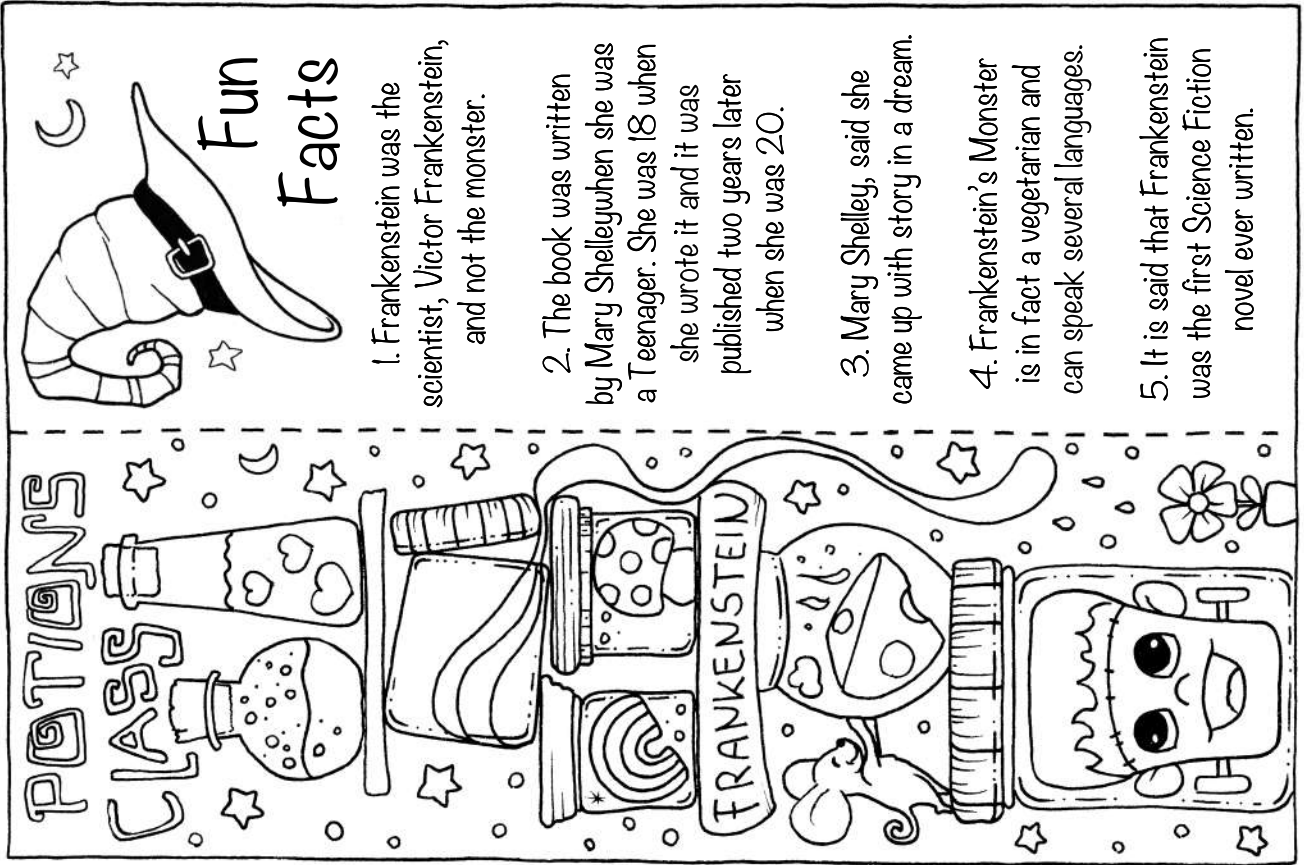
- Learn some basic facts about Mary Shelley and Frankenstein.

- Hone your writing skills with some creative story prompts or use to the sheet to practice some spooky spellings.



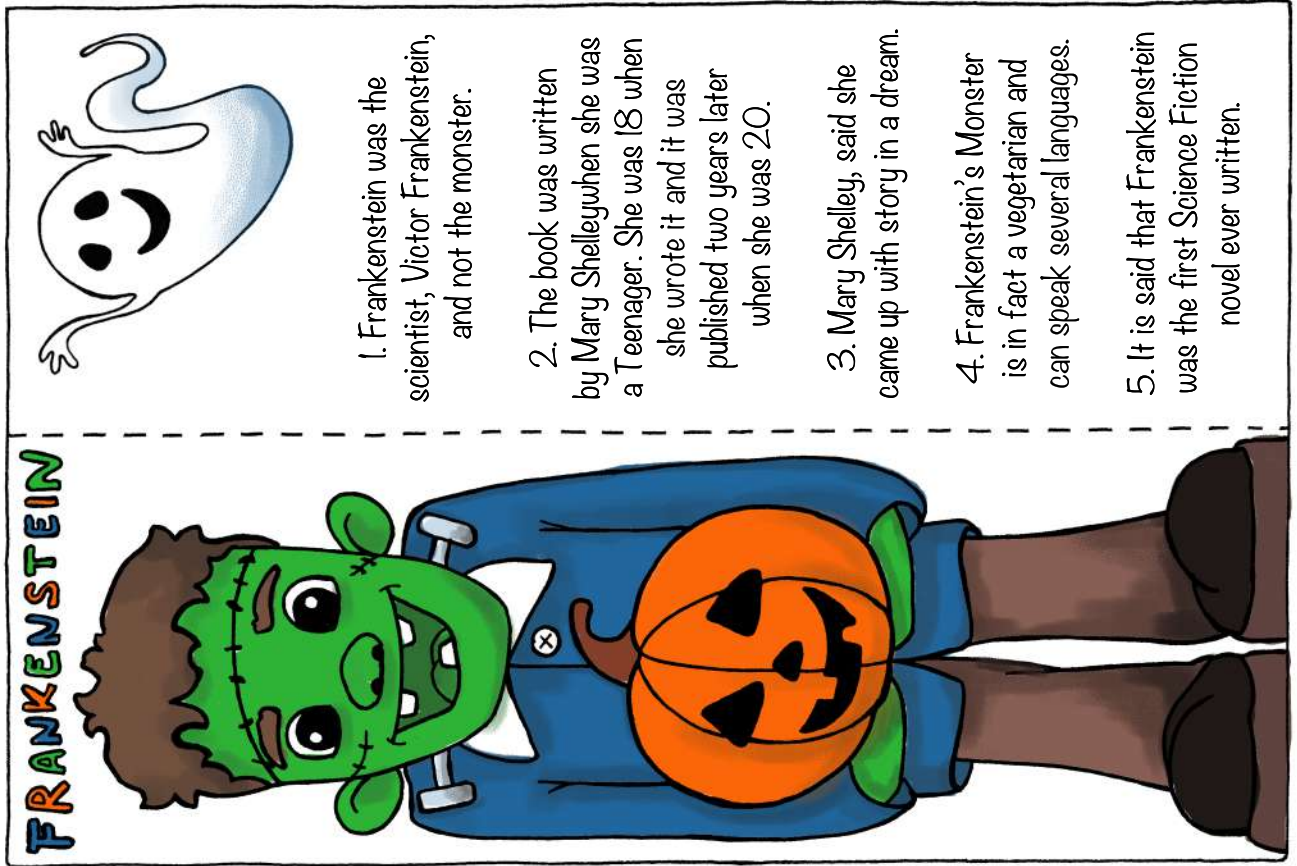
RedTedArt Frankenstein Bookmarks

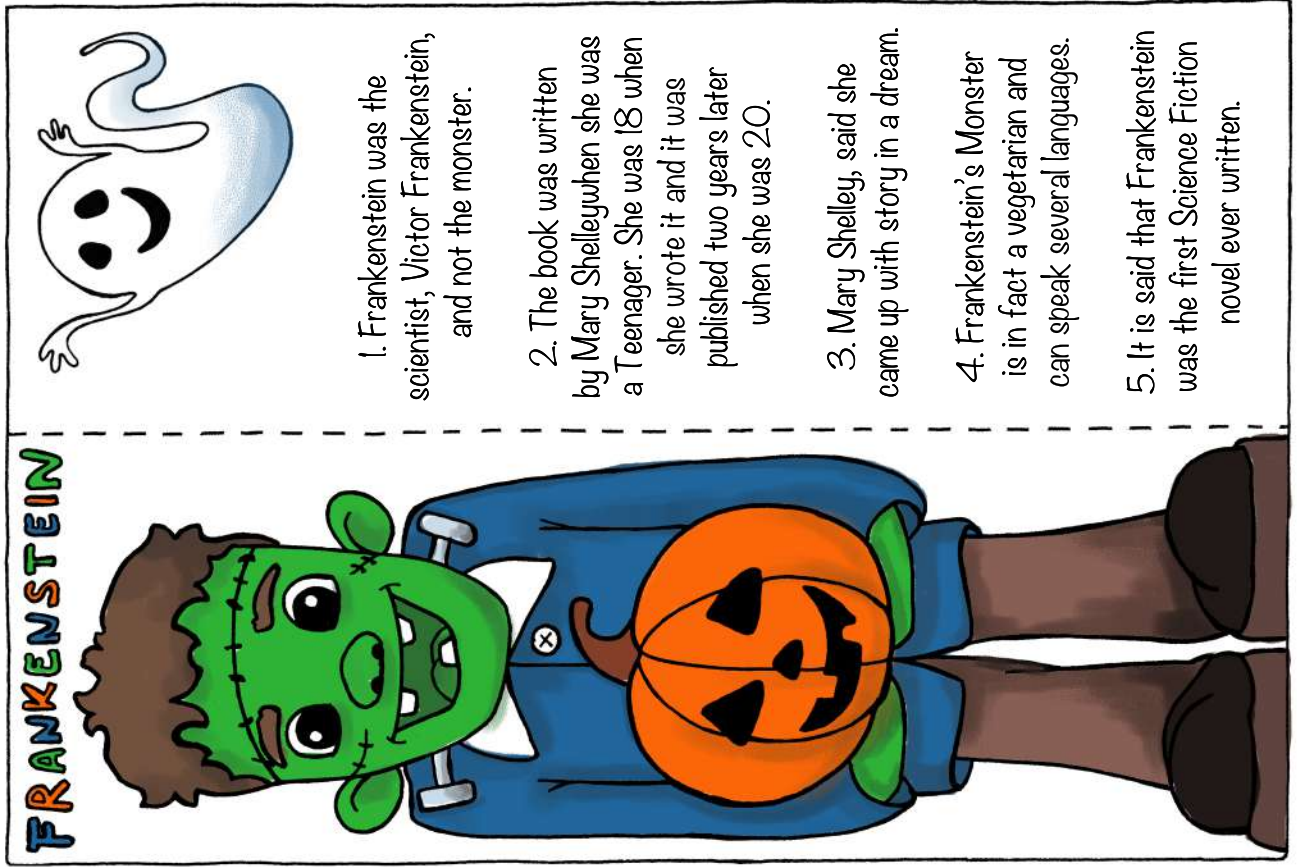


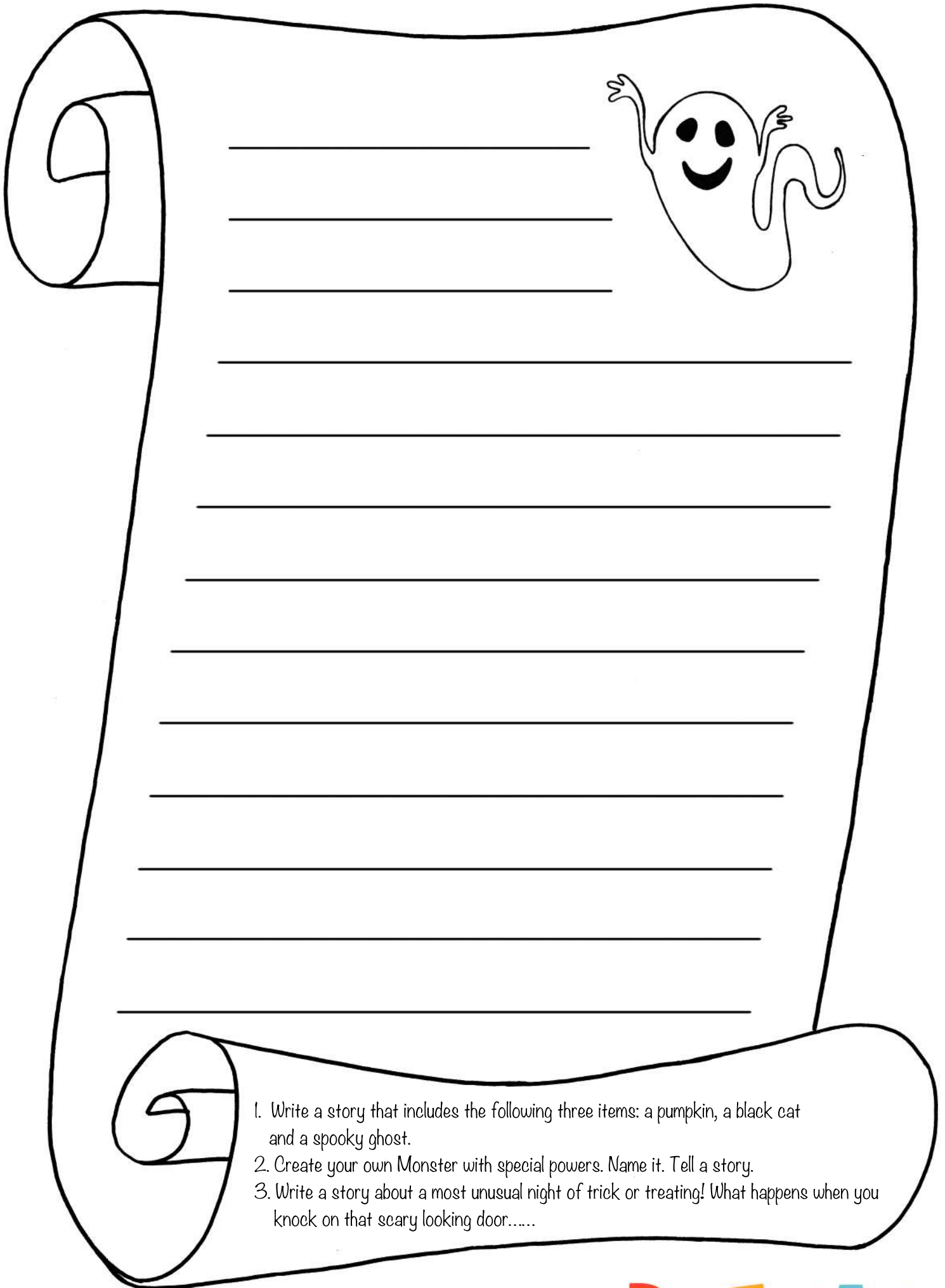
