

Principles of Kwanzaa

Bookmarks Instructions

Supplies

- HP Premium Paper
- 1 1/2yard of 1/4in. ribbon
- Single hole punch
- All purpose glue stick

Step 1: Print bookmarks and cut out along the outer edges.

Step 2: Fold along the center red line and glue wrong sides together

Step 3: Punch a hole in the center top edge

Step 4: Cut ribbon to eight 6 in. lengths

Step 5: Thread ribbon through the hole and secure
