



# **SA CVRN Award for PhD Rising Star in Cardiovascular Research**

**2024 Guidelines and Application Form**

## Instructions to applicants

Please read the instructions carefully before completing the application form. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

**Closing Date: 5pm, Monday 20 May 2024**

### Background

In 2024 we are pleased to offer the inaugural SA CVRN Awards for Cardiovascular Research to recognise and celebrate outstanding contributions to research in cardiovascular diseases, including diabetes, stroke and renal disease.

The SA CVRN Awards for PhD Rising Star in Cardiovascular Research specifically recognises research excellence in doctoral studies for a researcher up to one year post PhD. In 2024 three PhD Rising Star in Cardiovascular Research Awards are available for each of the following research areas; Basic - Biomedical / Clinical Medicine and Science / Public Health.

Application for this Award is by nomination by a Senior Researcher or Senior Executive in a similar or related field (can be the Nominee's supervisor).

### Who can be nominated?

Any researcher who is currently enrolled and nearing the end of their candidature but is yet to submit their thesis, or any researcher who has had their PhD conferred within one year prior to the closing date, and has pursued their PhD in SA, and has demonstrated excellence in cardiovascular research in their thesis submission.

### Selection criteria

Excellence in achievement in cardiovascular research is demonstrated by the researcher's Track Record during and post PhD candidature (excluding achievements and Track Record prior to PhD enrolment).

A strong Track Record could include, but is not limited to:

- Specific research achievements
- Research impact and benefit
- Originality and significance
- Collaboration achievements
- Publications' record
- Grants awarded
- Awards and prizes.

### Eligibility criteria

The PhD Rising Star Awards are open to residents of SA working in research in cardiovascular disciplines, including diabetes, stroke and renal disease.

#### Note:

- Only individual researchers are eligible (not research teams).
- The Nominee must be a member of the SA Cardiovascular Research Network (SA CVRN). If you are not a member of the SA CVRN, it is free to [join](#).
- Nominees must be either enrolled as a PhD Candidate and nearing the end of their candidature, or have had their PhD conferred in the 12 months prior to the closing date, (i.e., after 20 May 2023).
- Only Candidates who pursued their PhD in SA are eligible.
- Nominees must either be permanent residents or citizens of Australia.
- Self-nominations are not eligible.
- The winner is expected to attend the Awards Ceremony, 29 June 2024, unless extenuating circumstances will prevent attendance.

### Nomination requirements

Nominators should hold a senior research or executive position and be from a similar or related field to that of the Nominee (can be the Nominee's supervisor). Nomination forms should be completed by the Nominator and Nominee.

A completed form should include:

- Nominator's reference and statement endorsing the Nominee;
- An outline by the Nominee of their research; and
- Nominee's brief resume or curriculum vitae (maximum 2 pages) and key publications (maximum 1 page) completed by the Nominee.

Entries with insufficient documentation or documentation in excess of requirements, or those received after the closing date, will not be considered. Submitted material will not be returned.

### **Selection procedure**

The SA CVRN Award Review Committee may include representatives from the relevant CVD research community, both within SA and nationally. The Review Committee will shortlist applicants against the selection criteria.

From the shortlist, the Review Committee will reach their decision on the recipients of the award solely on the material submitted by the Nominees and Nominators. The deliberations of the Review Committee will remain confidential. The decisions of the Review Committee in the selection of the Award recipients are final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

### **Award**

Recipients of a SA CVRN Award for PhD Rising Star in Cardiovascular Research will receive a framed certificate alongside public and peer recognition at the SA CVRN Awards Ceremony.

Winners will also receive a cash prize of \$1,000 each, intended to support their career in cardiovascular research.

### **Privacy legislation**

Individuals, investigators or research institutions associated with SA CVRN Awards shall abide by the current NHMRC Guidelines issued pursuant to Section 95 of the Privacy Act 1988. All applications will be treated confidentially and will only be viewed by assessors, review committees, and SA CVRN staff.

### **Closing date**

Applications must be submitted by the Nominator.

All nominations must be received by 5pm ACST on Monday 20 May 2024.

Following receipt, each nomination will be thoroughly checked for completion. When all relevant information has been obtained, the nomination will be submitted to the Review Committee for consideration.

### **When are recipients advised?**

Shortlisted applicants will be notified approximately 4 weeks prior to the Awards Ceremony. Shortlisted applicants may be requested to participate in promoting and marketing of the Awards, prior to the Ceremony.

The winner of the Award will be announced at the SA CVRN Awards Ceremony, and following the Awards, the recipient will be advised officially in writing of the offer of the award. The name of the successful Nominee will be published on the SA CVRN, Heart Foundation Website.

The SA CVRN Awards Ceremony will be held on Saturday 29 June 2024. .

### **Are nominators advised**

Nominators are advised of the outcome of their nomination coincident with notification of shortlisted applicants.
