Certainty of
evidence

People successfully treated with fibrinolytic therapy should be transferred to a PCI-capable centre as soon as possible. Angiography should be performed within 2–24 hours upon arrival.

Strong

Moderate

Consider transferring people as soon as possible to a PCI-capable centre if fibrinolytic therapy is unsuccessful. If appropriate, consider subsequent PCI at the centre.

Weak

Moderate
