Who can enter

Contest is open to Australian workers aged 18 years or more from either healthcare or non-healthcare organisations who submit a photo entry for the Heart Week 2026 Creative Display Competition.

General practices are eligible to enter the **General Practice Prize**, and entries must be submitted on behalf of a general practice team.

Non-general practice healthcare teams—such as hospitals, pharmacies, community health services, allied health teams, specialist clinics and other healthcare providers—are eligible to enter the **Healthcare Prize**.

Any non-healthcare organisation, including workplaces, community groups and businesses that are not healthcare providers, is eligible to enter the **Organisation Prize**.

Employees and volunteers of the promoter and their immediate family members ARE NOT eligible to enter.

How to enter

Contest can be entered by:

- Posting photo/s of your decorated healthcare workplace or shared patient setting publicly on social media (Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, Twitter), **tagging the Heart Foundation** and using the hashtag **#HeartWeek2026**; OR

Judging

This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winners.

The winning entry will be the entry judged to be **most creative and unique for its category**.

Judging will take place remotely between Monday 18 May and Tuesday 26 May 2026. Judges will be provided with a spreadsheet containing all eligible entries and will review and score the entries individually and independently in their own time. Each judge will assign a score out of 10 to every entry. Once all judges have submitted their scores, the scores for each entry will be aggregated, and the entry in each category with the highest total score will be declared the winner. Judging will not take place via a group session.

Judges decision is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into.

All entries submitted become the property of the Promoter. Entries will not be returned to any entrant.
