In all people with suspected or confirmed ACS, give aspirin (300 mg orally, dissolved or chewed) unless contraindicated.

Strong

People with suspected or confirmed ACS with oxygen saturation (SpO<sub>2</sub>) ≥90% do not require oxygen therapy.

Strong

Moderate

In people with suspected or confirmed ACS receiving oxygen therapy, SpO<sub>2</sub> should not exceed 96%.

Strong

Moderate

In the presence of ongoing chest pain, give glyceryl trinitrate sublingual tablet or spray every 5 minutes for up to three doses if no contraindications exist.

Consensus

In people with chest pain and in the absence of contraindications, it is reasonable to administer intravenous (IV) fentanyl or morphine boluses.
