

Table 11a. Determinants of recurrent ischaemic risk following an ACS ([310](#), [372](#))

Low ischaemic risk

- Aged <75 years
- Not left main/left anterior descending artery disease
- Non-complex PCI

High ischaemic risk

- STEMI
- Left main/left anterior descending artery disease
- Complex PCI*
- Recurrent events on DAPT

Persisting high ischaemic risk

- Complex PCI*
- Recurrent events on DAPT

* Complex PCI: >2 stents/lesions/vessels treated, bifurcation stenting, >60mm of stent, chronic total occlusion.
