





# **APRIL SUMMARY**



#### **MAKE AND MODEL**

The top 5 fastest-selling models in April maintained strong momentum, led again by the BYD Atto 3, which improved its days to sell and held its position. Newer high-value entries like the Kia Niro and Mercedes-Benz Sprinter show signs of consumers stretching their budgets—higher price points are no longer a barrier if value is clear. On the flip side, luxury European models continue to dominate the slowest-selling list, with longer selling times and bigger discounts than last month.

#### **BODY TYPE**

Utes once again led for fastest-selling body type (24 days), maintaining their consistent strength since December. SUVs continued their slowdown trend, with time to sell increasing to 36 days and market days supply jumping from 51 in March to 56 in April.

#### **FUEL TYPE**

Diesel kept its top spot as the fastest-selling fuel (26 days), with consistent pricing and demand since January. EVs improved to 27 days to sell—down from 28 last month—while hybrid petrol models maintained 34 days to sell; however, market days supply increased to 52. Hybrid diesel remains the slowest segment at 43 days and 43 market days supply.

### **DOES AGE MATTER?**

Vehicles from 2021–2023 continue to outperform with only 26 days to sell and low discounting, showing enduring demand for "near new" stock. 2024 vehicles held at 39 days to sell, but high market days supply (50) keeps pressure on. 2025 models, although limited in volume, reduced days to sell down to 91.

#### **HOT PICKS**

Toyota dominates again with 5 of the top 10 fastest sellers, including three different RAV4 variants—showing consistent mainstream appeal across years and price points. The Ford Everest (2021 and 2022) and Subaru Outback also maintain top-10 status, highlighting continued interest in practical SUVs. Older value models like the Honda Fit and Mazda Demio sneak into the top 10, driven by affordability and quick turnover.


#### **STANDARD ISSUE**

Ford Ranger (2021) retains top listing volumes and solid performance, with 25 days to sell and relatively low discounting (31%). Toyota Aqua models (2012–2015) continue to face higher market days supply and high discounting. New entrant Mazda Axela (2014) joins the most-listed group—yet is showing high days to sell and oversupply in the market, one to watch.



# **BODY TYPE** DEMAND BY SHAPE AND SIZE





# FUEL TYPE DEMAND BY FUEL TYPE






